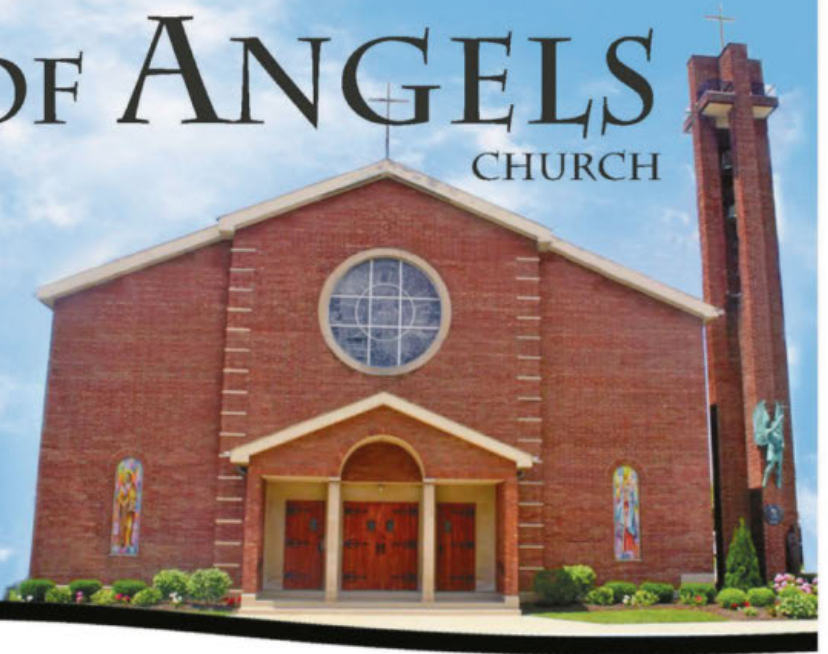


QUEEN OF ANGELS CHURCH

Reflection

The Gospel today guides us in addressing a brother's sin privately, involving witnesses only when necessary and engaging the church if needed. Jesus' instructions about approaching a brother who has sinned mirror the principles of confession and reconciliation within the Church. It reflects the aspect of seeking forgiveness and restoring one's relationship with God and the community. This guide promotes forgiveness and justice in a way to overcome animosity and maintain harmony. It resonates with the concept of conversion, as it invites individuals to examine their hearts, admit wrongdoing and seek reconciliation.

Jesus' assurance of his presence when two or three gather in his name emphasizes his divine presence in a united community and the connection of among believers and their role in support each other's spiritual journey.

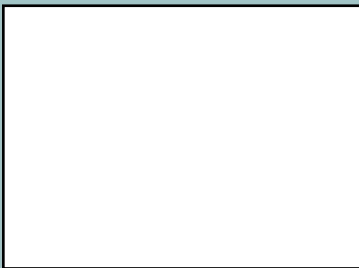
