Father Bill's Column

CHRISTMAS – LIGHT OF JESUS

CHRIST, GOD'S SON, LORD JESUS YOUR BIRTH WE NOW PROCLAIM AS WE LIGHT THE CENTER CANDLE WE NOW GLORIFY YOUR NAME THE ANGELS SANG TO BETHLEHEM AS A NEW STAR LIT THE SKIES GIFT OF CHRISTMAS, NEWBORN SAVIOR TO BOW BEFORE IS WISE!

As we utilize our newly installed cameras and streaming system, this Christmas comes to all who will receive the Good News of Jesus Christ. In our two linked parishes, we usually put the Advent wreath away as the church gets decorated for Christmas. (Our THANKS so much to the volunteers who did that this year!)

Some churches have a tradition of keeping the wreath and placing a single white candle in the center to represent the light of Christ. This practice is probably an offshoot of the use of our Paschal candle blessed each year at the Easter Vigil.

A few months ago, I was contacted by a church musician who came across my Advent Wreath Carol (whose lyrics I have used as part of my bulletin column reflections these past several weeks.) Good Shepherd Evangelical Lutheran Church in Springfield, Ohio asked for the music for my song to teach their choir. I quickly sent it.

Then I heard from the woman (whose name is Carol – yes. Ironic for a Christmas choir director, eh??) that their tradition includes the Christ candle on Christmas. Could I write another verse? I was happy to – and share that lyric with you at the top of this column with a prayer that this Christmas season will find you deeply immersed in the light and love of God's Son, our Lord <u>and</u> Good Shepherd, Jesus Christ!




Planning a Wedding
