Father Bill's Corner

"JESUS ALSO WAS BAPTIZED"

There is a hint of Good Shepherd in St. Matthew's telling of the Baptism of the Lord in this Sunday's gospel. It caught my attention that this telling of the luminous mystery uniquely starts with all the people being baptized, and then, "Jesus also." We city and suburb dwellers might picture a shepherd leading from the front of a flock, but normally then come from behind — to better watch out for wanderers!

"AND WAS PRAYING"

The three-word phrase above can seem like a throw-away, as if the gospel wants to say, "Oh, by the way, Jesus was praying." But no, my friends! Indeed, this seems quite essential to the narrative.

I picture Christ at the Jordan shore praying for each one baptized before Him. Was it catechesis by infusion? The prophetic word of John, that the one coming after him would, "baptize in the Holy Spirit," could have actually begun by His holy presence and prayer. Then, after his immersion in the Jordan, Jesus' prayer harmonizes with the sky opening, dove descending and the voice of the Father teaching!

"WELL PLEASED"

The voice of the Heavenly Father proclaims that Jesus is His "beloved son" and before Christ preaches a word or evokes a single miracle, God is "well pleased." At a certain moment, later after John the Baptist is arrested, scripture tells us that Jesus went "beyond the Jordan."

In many obvious ways, the Son of God supernaturally surpasses the ministry of John. Of course, the great prophet who recognized the presence of the savior while still in the womb foresaw this greatness! In a figurate way, after being baptized Himself, the Lord goes out to begin public ministry.

We who belong to Christ, His Father and the Holy Spirit through baptism are called to reach into the deep recesses (like a well!) of grace that saves us. Then we will resemble the Son of God as living out our baptism fully, beyond the Jordan. And by extension, then, our discipleship is also beyond Calvary, empty tomb and Pentecost. That is a bottomless well, is it not? Well, well!

Today the Church celebrates the Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord. This brings to an end the season of Christmas. The Church recalls Our Lord's second manifestation which occurred on the occasion of His baptism in the Jordan. Jesus did not need the baptism of John. He was absolutely sinless. At Christ's baptism the Holy Spirit descended upon Him; at our Baptism the Trinity took its abode in our soul. At His baptism Christ was proclaimed the "Beloved Son" of the Father; at our Baptism we become the adopted children of God.


