Let's face it: Talking about love is not everyone's cup of tea. While some people could discuss love for hours on end, others it makes highly uncomfortable and, quite frankly, agitated. Whether it brings back a painful memory of getting our heart broken, or even just the misconception that the concept of 'love' automatically means 'romance,' it's definitely a touchy subject. (Especially in 2023.)

However, if there's one thing St. Paul makes clear in his letter to the Romans this week, it's this: Love isn't going anywhere. In fact, it's our destiny and purpose. It's our end goal.

St. Paul even reminds us to <gasp> love our neighbor, meaning everyone around us. In a time of so much division, debate, and violence, it seems almost impossible to even like each other let alone love each other. Instead of showing each other kindness, compassion, understanding, and respect, we show each other animosity, cruelty, and rudeness.

While we're never going to all be each other's best friend, let's take St. Paul's words to heart. Let's try just a little bit harder. Let's remember to pray for each other. Let's put away our discomforts and learn to love again. Let's remember Jesus's new commandment: Love one another as I have loved you.

# FR. BILL'S CORNER

#### **EVER BEEN TO A HEALING MASS?**

Occasionally, we hear of a church holding a special Mass that will include prayer for healing. I have attended a whole variety of them. Actually, I have presided at them and prayed with people for healing for decades.

Last year, when I became pastor of the Catholic Family of South Buffalo, I called Fr. Bob Hora who had been assisting with Mass coverage at Our Lady of Charity. In our initial conversation, he brought up the fact that he has a great devotion to Padre Pio (formally now called St. Pius of Pietrelcina). He also shared that he has celebrated Healing Masses on or near the saint's feast day – and wondered whether we might schedule one in the Family. It was very close to September 23rd, so I suggested we put it on the calendar for 2023.



Padre Pio's feast falls on a Friday this year – less than two weeks from now – so we decided to hold the Mass at our weekly Thursday evening liturgy at 6:30 p.m. at Holy Family. Last month we offered a Mass for vocations, this month a Healing Mass.

Among many things that inspire me about St. Pio is the way his intense and mystical way of celebrating the Most Holy Eucharist was the center of his vocation. It seems that the Lord's gift of the stigmata—the wounds in the hands, feet and side that Padre Pio manifested while praying in a profound state in front of a crucifix – is connected to the Mass as sacrifice.

Fr. Bob will have a first-class relic of the saint for veneration at the Mass on September 22nd. He, myself and a few other priests will offer the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick which is a healing gift from our Lord Jesus.

I wrote this column a few weeks ago in anticipation of my pilgrimage to Medjugorje. The thought that came to me initially in composing an invitation to the Healing Mass is contained in the heading of this column. There may be parishioners who feel that because they have no diagnosis of serious illness, do not need a cane or wheelchair, that they have no need of healing.

May I ask you to consider that our need for healing goes far beyond the physical? Certainly the chronic illnesses, anticipation of surgery and advanced age are the usual reasons to be anointed. But anxiety, depression, broken/grieving hearts as well as anger, fear and despair (seeming hallmarks of our post-covid and divided society) are also very good reasons.

My mother once brought a friend who had suffered a stroke to a Healing Mass – and mom received a surprising gift from the Holy Spirit. Please pray about joining us to honor Padre Pio. Bring whatever wounds you have (mind, body, heart, etc.) and pray with us to Jesus who is the source of all healing ministry. Have you ever been to a Healing Mass? If not, at least come to pray for those most in need. See what the God of Surprises has for us—and YOU!


