Couples should begin planning with the parish at least six months prior to the wedding date. A marriage program is an essential part of the planning process.





The Mobile Pantry

The Mobile Pantry will be in the parking lot every second Friday of the month. Sign up starts at 11:30am, the truck comes at noon. All are welcome, just bring your ID and reusable bags. We can always use volunteers to help distribute the food.

We also collect bottles and cans. They can be dropped off at the pantry during business hours, Monday, 10am-2pm, Wednesday, 9am-3pm or Friday 9am-12noon.


