## From the Desk of Deacon Dave

Have you ever been to Sak's Fifth Avenue? Me neither. I saw an ad from Saks just recently. There was a picture of a simple woman's shirt. A top, and the price was \$3,900. No kidding, \$3,900! I am glad that my wife Kay does not shop there. It makes me wonder. I think it is great occasionally to do something that costs a little more than usual to make an occasion special. Maybe an extra nice outfit or a nice dinner as a birthday gift. But there is a limit and \$3,900 far exceeds that limit for a woman's shirt! Can you imagine all the good you could do with \$3,900? For the poor? For the hungry? I believe you could work miracles with that same \$3,900 that some might spend for a shirt.

In our Psalm this weekend we hear, "The hand of the Lord feeds, he answers all our needs." Had the psalmist looked around? Didn't they see all the people in need? Today we know that there are plenty of needs that we and the people around us have. Our Gospel reminds us that there is a difference between our "needs" and our wants. We might feel that we need a larger GPS so we can read the screen easier, but we do not "need" one. We can want the \$3,900 shirt, but we do not "need" one. A "need" is something we cannot live without. We cannot live without food or shelter. We need it. We do not need the larger GPS screens or a \$3,900 shirt.

In our Gospel this weekend, Jesus performs a miracle by feeding thousands of people with only 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish. A miracle. This was not a dinner at a 5-star restaurant, just the food that was needed.

We are being called to work miracles. To work the miracle of seeing to it that no one is left in need of food or the basic necessities of life. It is through the actions and you and I that, "The hand of the Lord feeds us, he answers all our needs."

This week, consider beginning a regular donation of food or dollars to our Food Pantry. And every day, stay informed as to how you can make a difference in the way our society feeds the hungry. You are already off to a good start if you did not buy the \$3,900 shirt!
