# Pastor's Corner

"I cry out to you, 'Violence' but you do not intervene." The prophet Habakkuk is shocked at the destruction all around him and God's response to it. There is a lot of shock and outrage these days about many things in our world. Sadly, one of them doesn't seem to be the scourge of abortion. Our readings on "Respect Life Sunday" encourage us to fight the good fight and remind us that "God did not give us a spirit of cowardice but rather of power and love and self-control." Sometimes we can feel pressure to be in with the popular crowd and have people admire us; but that is not what our Lord, Jesus experienced in his life. So, St. Paul encourages us to "not be ashamed of your testimony to our Lord." Today we remember and defend the gift of life. That might not be a safe or popular topic; nor is our Catholic response to it. I hope you will challenge yourself to be open to our Christian understanding of the sanctity of all life and not be pressured into the worldly stance toward this controversial topic. After the 11 am Mass (at 12:00) today, I will bless any "furry (and feathered) friends" you bring to the front of church in honor of the Feast of St. After that we will pray for an even Francis. more precious thing; the unborn *child's* right to a safe and healthy birth as each of us becomes an important "link" in our annual (national) "Life Chain." This year we will be participating in the "Southtowns Life Chain" which will convene at Nativity Church in Orchard Park, from 2:30 to 3:30. This is a change in the information we had last week and I apologize for any inconvenience or confusion. Please meet at 2 pm in the SMOL parking lot (to carpool) or we will see you there at Nativity Church at 2:30 pm. I would love to see our teens and young families there. But even if you cannot make it today, please pray that as "unprofitable servants" of Jesus we will always "do what we are obliged to do" for as God reminds Habakkuk and us today, "the just one, because of his faith, shall live."
