Baptism: Celebrated Sundays at 1:00 p.m. or by appointment. For the parents, a required preparation session is held monthly. Godparents must be in good standing in the Catholic Church. Please call the parish office for further information and to schedule.

Confirmation: Celebrated annually with the Bishop. Please call the Director of Faith Formation to begin sacramental preparation.

Eucharist: Celebrated daily. See the next page for the Mass schedule and for information regarding upcoming Holy Days of Obligation. *Low-gluten hosts are available during all Masses at St. Peter's for those who are in need of it for health reasons. Please present yourself to the priest presider in his line for Holy Communion at the time of distribution with your request.

Reconciliation: Celebrated weekly on Saturdays at 3:15 p.m. at St. Raphael's, on Saturdays at 3:30 p.m. at St. Peter's, on Thursdays at 6:30 p.m. at St. Bernard's or by appointment.

Anointing of the Sick: Celebrated upon request - we are happy to visit you with Communion, Confession or to offer the Sacrament of Anointing in your home, hospital or healthcare facility. Also celebrated after the Last Thursday Mass of the calendar month at St. Bernard's and the Last Saturday Morning Mass of the calendar month at St. Raphael's.

Marriages & Convalidation of Marriage: Call the office and meet with one of the clergy to begin making arrangements for the celebration of your wedding, at least 6 months in advance of the proposed date.

PASTOR'S COLUMN

Can you believe we are about to start the season of Lent?!?! It always sneaks up on us so fast as these winter months go by in a blur. I've always found that many people find the season of Lent to be a personally meaningful time as they take the opportunity to spiritually reengage, recommit, reconnect, reinvigorate, rediscover, reaffirm, reestablish, rejuvenate, respond, reconcile, rehabilitate, refresh, reset, retreat, renew ...

All of us know a share in the brokenness of this world and need to re: (fill in the blank here) every once in awhile in order to get ourselves back on track to where we'd like to be. Indeed, God Himself leads us in this opportunity. The Gospel, the Good News, is that God understands this about us, accepts us for who we are and yet wants so much more for you and me. 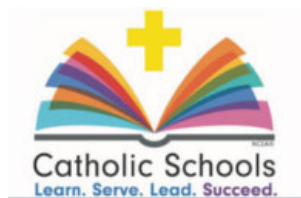

The Liturgy of the Day

As we approach Ash Wednesday and the season of repentance and penitence, we hear how Jesus responded to a man who was considered unclean, both physically and spiritually. Over the following forty days, we will approach our Lord as sinners, in need of forgiveness, in need of being "made clean." May Jesus' response to the leper in today's Gospel assure us of His love and mercy for us despite our failings, despite our sinfulness.


Scripture Reflection: The leper in today's Gospel recognized Jesus for more than a healer, for a healer could only cure an illness. The leper, recall, specifically asked to be made clean. He wanted God's punishment to be removed. He wanted the barrier between him and the community to be removed. Jesus removed that barrier the moment He touched him, bridging the gap between community and outcast, even before healing him. In touching the man, Jesus would have been considered to have made Himself impure. But far from making Himself less than whole, He is making the community whole by restoring the leper to it.


