FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

January 2, 2022
Feast of the Epiphany

To My Spiritual Family of Holy Redeemer and St. Anthony,

A New Year of Grace: "Behold, I make all things new (Rev 21:5)!" What a beautiful promise we have from our Lord! Whatever the past year has been (and admittedly, it hasn't been all we had hoped for), Jesus Christ offers a new beginning. As sinners, we absolutely need that new beginning. And God, in his mercy, not only forgives, but he heals and binds and restores. As the bearers of a fragile human condition, we often find ourselves wounded, broken, and on the point of losing hope. But we must never lose hope! Christ is a God of hope! He is hope! So we place the new year into his hands. We turn to Mary, our Mother, seeking her guidance and intercession. We ask our guardian angels and our patron saints to be at our sides. And then with shoulders back, chins up, and knees bent in prayer . . . we march confidently into 2022.

Tithing Our Blessings: Our initial parish tithe for this new year will be used to form a parish "emergency fund." We did the same last year, and used that emergency money to support people who were desperately in need. I like to say that our parish is not a bank. Our goal isn't to increase our assets for the sake of increasing our assets, but to use them for God's purposes. We exist as a church family to preach the Gospel of Christ and to build up his kingdom. The money that you so unselfishly offer to the parish must be used principally for those objectives. And since God has a tender concern for the poor, so we too must seek to alleviate the want and the suffering of those most in need. Speaking both for myself and for the Pastoral Council, we want to express our sincere admiration for the good you have made possible through the monthly parish tithes (recall that we tithe 10% of our weekend collections). Please know that your generosity in 2021 resulted in almost \$30,000 being given to local and international charities. That's tremendous! From the poor here in Warren County to disaster victims in Haiti, you made a real difference in the lives of so many. Thank you! Thank you! Thank you! The teaching of our Lord on such generosity is clear: "As you did it to one of the least of my brethren, you did it to me (Mt 25:40)." Well, you fed and clothed and comforted Jesus in the year that has been. And through our 2022 parish tithes, we will be able to touch even more lives. Praise God!

The Most Important Resolution: Please recall the profound message of the Frenchman, Leon Bloy: *The only sadness is to not be a saint*. So beyond everything else we may wish to accomplish in this new year, growth in Christian discipleship and growth in holiness are the most important of resolutions. We are called to be saints! Yes, it takes discipline and ardor. And we live in a time when doing difficult things does not hold the same attraction that it once did. But we must do difficult things if our lives are to bear fruit for God's kingdom. We are not made for comfort. We are made for holiness! So let's redouble our efforts to pray daily, go to Mass weekly, and to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation monthly. And of course, we must also strive to love sacrificially and forgive without limit. None of this is easy, but our growth in holiness has eternal benefits for ourselves and for others. The world desperately needs you to be another Christ. So be a saint!

Please know of my continued prayers. I hope your New Year is a beautiful one. And whatever joys and challenges lie ahead, God will always be with us. Do not be afraid!

Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments

Online Gaming: 72% of teens, both male and female (ages 13-17) play video games. More than half of those teens said they have made new friends online. The National Center for Missing & Exploited Children analysis of Cyber Tipline reports has found that gaming platforms are more often used in the online enticement of young boys than any other group of children. It is important for parents to talk to their child about safety in online gaming. Some important questions to ask are: Have you ever been cyberbullied while gaming? Do you know what information is OK to share about yourself while gaming? Has anyone talked about sex while you were gaming or asked you to send pictures of yourself?
