To My Spiritual Family of Holy Redeemer and St. Anthony,

The Synod Progresses: Audrey Davis and Virginia Baker have been studying the materials and participating in training as they prepare to lead us as *Parish Facilitators* for the Church's *Synod on Synodality*. They are really excited about the process! Our first local "listening session" will be happening soon. Before that time, Audrey and Virginia will be explaining the process to us and making a formal invitation to participate. How is the Spirit inviting us to grow together in faith? Please spend some prayerful time pondering that question as we look forward to entering into the Synod discussions.

Daily Prayer: I hope you are persevering in daily prayer. Making the time for prayer in our busy world can certainly be a challenge, but as the old saying goes – If we are too busy to pray, then we are simply too busy! Prayer really is indispensable. Our souls thirst for the presence of God. More incredibly, God thirsts for us. Jesus said so on the cross: "I thirst (John 19:28)." Of course, our crucified Lord thirsted for water to drink as he underwent his terrible passion, but even more so, he thirsted for our love. St. Mother Teresa made sure that the words – I thirst - were visible in every Missionaries of Charity chapel. She wanted her sisters to be reminded daily that God thirsted for their love. Jesus thirsts no less for my love and for your love. We encounter that love in prayer. Yes, daily prayer requires discipline. Yes, it can seem tedious at times. Yes, we may question whether God is really there. But perseverance in prayer opens the door to God's heart. Many of you who are homebound or who have advanced in years are incredible prayer warriors. You are examples for the rest of us to emulate. But whatever our life situation may be, let's ensure that we are meeting the Lord every day in prayer!

Into the Word: Along with prayer, it is vital that we enter deeply into God's Word. The Bible is not some dead book. The scriptures are alive with God's power and love! Verses that we might have read 1,000 times suddenly take on new meaning and significance for us! Are you and I taking time each day to read the Word? Do we allow that Word to penetrate our souls? We never want our bibles to grow dusty from lack of use. Try downloading the "Amen" app if you have not already done so. Many parishioners have found "Amen" to be a great tool for receiving the scriptures. God wants to speak to our hearts. He does that beautifully through his Word!

Let's Get Ready to Rumble! The spiritual battle is real. The evil one wants our souls as a prize. So we must fight. Our weapons? Prayer, sacraments (the Eucharist and Confession in particular), fasting, self-denial, and love. Reading the lives of the saints is a powerful help. The rosary is another super-powerful way to fight the battle. What will really wound us? Apathy. Disbelief. Sloth. It's not easy being on the front lines. Perseverance in doing the good is necessary. But we never struggle alone. Christ is with us. He is Risen and victorious over sin and death. We can wave his banner with triumphant joy! We share in his glory!



Please note that a Confirmation date has been confirmed by the bishop's office. We will celebrate this beautiful gift of our Church with our young people on




