

### FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

February 20, 2022 7th Sunday in Ordinary Time

To My Spiritual Family of Holy Redeemer and St. Anthony,

**Bishop Meeting Summary**: I attended a February 8 meeting in Brockway at which Bishop Persico updated priests on the status of continuing Pastoral Planning efforts. Here is a summary of what I heard: (1) The Bishop made clear that the care of souls/bringing souls to Christ is the goal that we absolutely must remain focused upon as considerations are made for altering parish structures; (2) The Catholic communities in Oil City, Dubois, Bradford, and the East Side of Erie are actively engaged in planning efforts. In other words, they have begun a focused process of determining if their local parishes should be further merged or if some parishes should even be closed; (3) Possibly reflecting lessons learned from the past several years of restructuring, the Bishop indicated that there is no one-size-fits-all way of configuring parishes, and that he wants to ensure that the unique charisms and devotional practices of each community are taken into consideration; and (4) He signaled that the diocesan offices will take a more active role in Pastoral Planning initiatives.

**Synod Sessions**: Our parish listening sessions for the *Synod on Synodality* begin today! Audrey Davis and Virginia Baker will be facilitating three sessions: February 20 & 27, and March 6. All are from 1-3 in the lower level of Holy Redeemer Church. You are welcome to attend one session or all of them. We invite you to join Catholics from throughout the world in participating in this Synod.

Catholic Services Appeal: Although next weekend's Masses mark the "official" Commitment Sunday for the 2022 Catholic Services Appeal, pledges have already been pouring in. Thank you! Your financial sacrifices in support of the Catholic Church are greatly appreciated. My pledge this year is for \$2,000. I should never ask you to support this effort if I do not do so myself. Plus, our project this year is replacement of the Holy Redeemer church boiler, and I hate being cold! Thank you again and God bless you in every way!

Can you Hear Me Now: A number of you have expressed dismay that you cannot hear all that is being said during Mass at Holy Redeemer Church. This concerns me greatly. We have tried to tweak the sound system, but there is only so much that can be done to increase volume. Please know that we are bringing in professionals to make an evaluation. In the meantime, please do all that you can do as well. Thank you and I'll keep you informed.

Grandparents: The beautiful bond between a grandparent and a grandchild is not broken by the death of grandma or grandpa, you know. Here's an example. I talked recently with a young man who was carrying the pain of a broken heart. He admitted that he was in a place of real sadness and suffering. But where was he going to find comfort and counsel? To his grandmother's grave. He was confident that having a talk with grandma (despite the cold and snow of the cemetery) would provide some of the answers he was seeking. And no doubt, it did! So grandparents, never forget that you can have an amazing impact here on this earth, but even when that time comes for you to take up your heavenly residence, your grandparently influence endures!

Days Away: I'll be at my brother's from after Mass today (February 20) until I return for confessions and Mass on Thursday (February 24). Hopefully, a few days off will provide me with some rest and prepare me to charge energetically into Lent. I can neither confirm nor deny that due to my absence the parish staff will be rolling a barbeque pit and a keg into the T-K Room!






