To My Spiritual Family of Holy Redeemer and St. Anthony,

Lenten Readiness: The Holy season of Lent is almost upon us! March 2 – this Wednesday – is Ash Wednesday. Easter Sunday is on April 17 this year. The days in between, the days of Holy Lent, are given to us as a gift. Let's use the gift well. Let's make this a time of true conversion. Let's ensure that God is at the center of all we do during this 40-day penitential journey. *Repent!* That is our watchword. That is our task. We are all sinners. Yet God's mercy is infinitely greater than the worst of our sins. The tools that the Church gives us for Lent – prayer, fasting, and almsgiving – when used wisely and diligently, lead us to a place of holiness. The spiritual battle is real! Looking around at our world and our culture, we clearly see the effects of evil and sin. Yet it doesn't have to be this way. The Lord invites us to come back to him with all of our heart. He loves us. He offers us his mercy and compassion. So together as a parish, let's accept the Lord's invitation. If we all give ourselves fully to the repentance of Lent, grace will abound. No doubt! Beginning on this Wednesday, what will our commitment to prayer entail? Maybe we should write it down as a way of staying disciplined. What fasting is the Lord calling us to? Detachment from food, drink, the internet, or television are all possibilities. And to whom will we give alms? Our parish tithe for March will go to the Second Harvest Food Bank and our parish tithe for April will again support Haiti 180. Beyond all this, let's take advantage of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Let's be at Mass on Sundays for sure, but on weekdays as we can (Thursday night is a great opportunity). Lent is upon us. Let's together repent and believe the Good News of Jesus Christ!

Fridays and Thursdays: The most anticipated culinary happening of each Lenten season is undoubtedly the Friday fish fry sponsored by the Sheffield Knights of Columbus. Please drive to St. Paul Center any or all Fridays to enjoy their delicious meals. The cost of fish, like so many products, has risen substantially due to the high inflation, but somehow the Knights have managed to keep the fish fry price at a very reasonable rate. They are good men. Let's offer them our support. Thursday evenings in Warren, Deacon Ray will again lead the Stations of the Cross while I take up my station in the confessional. I can't encourage you enough to make these devotions an integral part of your Lenten experience. And if you are out Sheffield way, you can stop by St. Anthony on Tuesdays for the Stations of the Cross there.

Catholic Services Appeal: Commitments to this year's campaign have already been arriving at the parish office. Thank you for your generosity! Today is the "official" start-up date for the diocesan-wide CSA, so if you have not made a pledge, I humbly ask you to do so. God has been very good to our parish, and this is one way to return that goodness in support of the Church's mission. Again, I thank you for your generosity!




