April 10, 2022

Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

To My Spiritual Family of Holy Redeemer and St. Anthony,

That first **Palm Sunday**, as our Lord rode upon the donkey into Jerusalem, he was thinking of you. During the **Passover** supper in the Upper Room, with his apostles gathered around him, Jesus was remembering me. When his hour finally arrived, and as he hung in agony upon the cross, our Savior was picturing every human person ever to live. All this is amazing! All this is true! From his birth in Bethlehem to has last breath upon Calvary Hill, Jesus Christ was living his life in service to you and me. **He came to earth for us!** He preached and healed and drove out demons for us! He suffered and died and rose again for us! Make no mistake, **we are loved without limit** by the God of all the universe.

This week, this Holy Week, is not like others. These days, more than most days, are lived in prayer and contemplation. **O that our eyes be turned to Jesus**. O that our minds be filled with the thoughts of salvation. O that our hearts be given to Christ in love.

Sadly, much of the world will not even pause to remember the Savior's sacrifice. May it not be so for you or me! And so I ask you again, please commit to being at church for the feasts of this Holy Week. The Mass of the Lord's Supper draws us into the core mysteries of our faith: the Lord institutes the priesthood and he gives us the incomparable gift of the Eucharist. Furthermore, Jesus reminds us of the primacy of love. As we leave Mass on Holy Thursday evening, the altar will be stripped and the tabernacle left empty. With Jesus, we will walk into the darkness of the night and the reality of his betrayal. From the conclusion of the Mass of the Lord's Supper until nearly midnight, we will gather before the Altar of Repose. Jesus asks us the same question that he asked his apostles: "Could you not watch with me one hour (Mt 26:41)?"

Good Friday will find us with Jesus at Calvary Hill. His Mother, Mary, is there as well. So too is John and Mary Magdalene. But not all have remained. Peter denied him. The others ran away. Yet the cross becomes the throne of a King. You and I venerate this precious wood with sadness and wonder. No Mass is offered on Good Friday. No joyous hymns echo in our mind. This is a day for lamenting. This is a day for quiet prayer. This is a day when, like the veil within the Jerusalem temple, **our hearts too are torn asunder**.

Holy Saturday finds the Church waiting with our Blessed Mother and the hosts of heaven. All is strangely still. Joseph of Arimathea has buried Jesus. The women prepare spices. Pilate's soldiers guard the tomb. The apostles huddle in fear. Jesus has "descended into hell." The devil claims victory.

There is indeed a victory to be won. It's the victory of the Resurrection. But we are not there yet. Holy Week must be lived. Let us look upon these days as both a gift and a responsibility. What a privilege we are given to walk with Jesus as we remember his suffering and passion. Thankfully, we know that death is not the last word. Easter morning will yet dawn. For now, though, we wait, and we watch, and we pray, and we fast. God bless you throughout this week.


IMPORTANT REMINDER
