



#### Easter Sunday

Blessed Easter to all. In the Orthodox and Eastern Catholic Churches, all the people greet each other during the Easter season with: "The Lord is Risen!" The response is: "Indeed He is risen!" The meaning of the Resurrection escapes us and is quite mysterious. I believe it is enough for us to acknowledge and place our faith and trust in it and its promises rather than fully understand it. It is the very event in history which gives us hope, that says that all is not lost - even in the face of death. This promise of hope is so very important especially for those who mourn the loss of loved ones. This promise sheds a ray of light and consolation on the sadness and burdens of life.

The reason I became a priest is because of this resurrection event I did not personally witness, but someone I know close to me did. As you may remember I never wanted to be a priest growing up and was not very religious, but a story my Grandmother told me was the seed of faith for my life and vocation. In 1976 my grandfather Otto was dying in the Buffalo area. After saying goodbye to all of his ten children he was peacefully resting in his hospital bed with my Grandmother Leona at his side.

Then Our Lord Jesus appeared to them both at the foot of the bed for a few moments. My grandmother exclaimed: "Look Otto, Our Lord is here!" He passed shortly after. I asked my grandmother to repeat that story along with the details of Our Lord's appearance many times growing up. It was the seed of faith for me that meant Jesus truly rose from the dead and loves all of us dearly, especially in our greatest need. My Grandparents were very devout and simple people, both growing up on farms outside of Buffalo. It does not surprise me that Our Lord would reveal His Love to them in 1976 as He had done their whole lives.

Our Lord may have died on Good Friday, but He rose on the third day and opened the gates of heaven for all of us, our heavenly homeland. May we truly rejoice this Easter Season for our gift of faith, which sheds light and consolation on our lives and the lives of all of our loved ones.

The Lord is Risen...Indeed He is Risen!
