THE SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM

Baptism may continue to be celebrated. New water must be blessed for every individual baptism. Parents and Godparents must attend a Baptismal Preparation Class prior to the baptism.

RECONCILIATION

Father will hear individual confessions in the main body of the church honoring social distancing. Thursday before 1st Friday 4:00-5:00PM and every Saturday 3:30-4:30PM.

MATRIMONY

Marriages may continue to be celebrated, with some restrictions. With total number of those present including clergy, not to exceed 1/2 maximum capacity.

SICK AND HOME BOUND

Anointing of the Sick should continue as usual, based upon need. Non-emergency visits such as First Friday calls should be suspended.

FUNERALS

Funeral Masses continue to be celebrated with masks worn and social distancing with pews marked off.

PARISH REGISTRATION

A person becomes a member of the Catholic Church through Baptism. Active membership in a particular parish is a requirement for the celebration of marriage, for eligibility for confirmation, for baptism of one's child, for First Communion for one's child. Children are considered members with their parents until they turn 18 years old (or upon college graduation) at which time, it is their responsibility to attend church and to register as a member independent of their parent. There are certain minimum requirements for parish membership called the precepts of the Church. They include: **ATTEND SUNDAY MASS.** The first precept of the Church requires the faithful to participate in weekly Mass on Sunday. Since the parish weekly Mass envelopes are the primary way we can determine if parishioners are regularly attending Mass, it's important to place your envelopes in the collection basket every Sunday regardless of whether one is able to make a financial contribution.

SUPPORT OF THE CHURCH. The faithful also have the duty of providing for the material needs of the Church, each according to his/ her abilities in a regular, identifiable and meaningful way. This support of the church also includes assisting with parish programs/ activities in accordance with one's abilities/interests.

THE LORD BE WITH YOU!

Dear people of St. Mary's,

The Gospel for this 6th Sunday of Easter is the second part of Jesus' "vine and branches" lesson which we heard last Sunday. There we learned that remaining

connected to JESUS and His "word" is necessary in order to <u>do our part</u> of transmitting JESUS' divine life to others. JESUS likens this transmission of His life as fruitfulness [John 15:8]. Fruitfulness is also the point of the Gospel today, which concludes with JESUS' command "to go and bear fruit that will remain" [John 15:16].

Today we are provided with the key to understanding the word of GOD in which we are to remain so that we can be pruned and fruitful. The word *"remain"* leads us to this key. Last week we were urged to *"remain"* in JESUS' word [15:3-4,7]. This week we are encouraged to *"remain"* in JESUS' love [15:9]. Immediately we are provided with instruction on how to do so: *by keeping JESUS' commandments* [15:10].

Then JESUS quickly simplifies all GOD's commandments into one: *"love one another as I love you"* [15:12]. The key to interpreting JESUS' words in the Gospel of St. John is what they show us about how to love as JESUS loves. And to sharpen this perspective for us, JESUS immediately clarifies His kind of love: *"No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends"* [15:13]. THUS, *"remaining in JESUS' Word"* prunes us and nourishes others through us. This happens when JESUS' Word about <u>self-giving love</u> takes root in us.

When we approach JESUS' Word from the perspective of the kind of love that JESUS talks about and lived, then, GOD's life flows through us so freely that *"whatever you ask the Father in My name"* the Father will give you [15:16].

Let us pray: **"Bring us to live the focused love that JESUS lived <u>and remain in that</u> love, so <u>we will be fruitful</u>, and at peace with You, ourselves, and one another!"**
