

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)



THE LORD BE WITH YOU!



Dear people of St. Mary's,

Today we join in celebrating the **Feast of the Holy Family of JESUS, Mary, & Joseph**. The Sacred Scripture today shows us how quickly GOD's plan for salvation moves

from the birth of JESUS, His Son, just hours ago, to JESUS as a young teenager as he begins to engage in the work of establishing the Father's kingdom among us.

First, we learn that JESUS stays behind after the festival and then is found in the temple asking the teachers questions [Luke 2:43-46]. JESUS is also answering their questions, astonishing them with His wisdom and knowledge. When asked why He has done this without telling His parents, JESUS replies with a question that can be translated two ways: (1) *"Did you not know that I must be in my Father's house?"* or (2) *"Did you not know that I must be about my Father's business?"* [Luke 2:49b]. The words of JESUS can mean either and in fact seem to mean both. And, we will see that later accounts in the Gospel of St, Luke, are largely focused on JESUS doing GOD's will in the temple or while journeying to the temple. JESUS is already engaged in the work that GOD the Father has given Him.

Next, we see Mary & Joseph legitimately worried and puzzled. These emotions are clear in Mary's words to JESUS after finding Him: *"Son, why have You done this to us? Your father and I have been looking for You with great anxiety"* [Luke 2:48]. There is much that Mary has experienced that has been perplexing and much that she will experience in the life of her son, JESUS, that will be difficult to grasp in the light of His role as GOD's Son. But Mary has the disposition to grow in her faith because she is willing to reflect on her experiences of GOD in her life. Following JESUS' answer quoted above [Luke 2:49b], we hear, *'and His mother kept all these things in her heart"* [Luke 2:51]. You may remember that Mary does the same thing when she hears what the shepherds say about JESUS after His birth [Luke 2:19].

Let us pray: Lord GOD, give us the grace to follow the example of Mary [& Joseph] through the Christmas Season and beyond. May the way we live, sing out our witness to You: "Glory to GOD in the highest and peace to His people on earth!"
