THE LORD BE WITH YOU!



Dear people of St. Mary's,

May God bless YOU as we celebrate the Epiphany of our Lord!

AND, just what do we celebrate on this solemn feast day? GOD tells us in His own words, paraphrasing the prophecy of Isaiah 60:1-6, "the Lord's light shines upon His people, and they then radiate His light to the world around them. . . . and caravans shall come bearing gold and frankincense, and proclaiming the praises of the Lord."

Then GOD explains through the Gospel of St. Matthew 2:1-12, that what GOD foretold through the prophet Isaiah now happens, when Mary gives birth to GOD's own Son and the magi caravan to see Him, guided by the star in the east, which signaled the birth of the newborn King of Israel. When they arrived they did Him homage and offered Him gifts of gold, frankincense, & myrrh.

So just as GOD showed Himself to His own people [symbolized by the shepherds] who came with their flocks to worship Him on the night of His birth, <u>now</u> GOD shows Himself to the whole world, the non-Jews [symbolized by the magi/wisemen/kings] who came from the far corners of the world [from the East] bearing "kingly" gifts and who did Him homage.

Indeed, GOD has come among us, to bring salvation to ALL people of all times—even to YOU and me. Christ JESUS, the GOD-man is the King and Savior of all. That is what we celebrate today!

Let us pray <u>often</u> for one another and support one another's efforts to be renewed in our commitments to follow Christ more closely in this New Year: **GOD bring us to be more attentive to the many ways You continue to be revealed to us in Christ—through His words and deeds when as hear the Gospel—and also through His presence in the sacraments [most dramatically in the Holy Eucharist]—and through the many gifts of creation, especially one another.**


