Ash Wednesday Homily 2021 by Pope Francis

Lent is a journey that involves our whole life, our entire Pastor's Desk being. It is a time to reconsider the path we are taking...to rediscover our relationship with God, on whom everything

Lent is not about the little sacrifices we make, but about discerning where our hearts are directed. Let us ask: Where is my life's navigation system taking me—towards God or towards myself? Do I live to please the Lord, or to be noticed, praised, put at the head of the line? Do I have a "wobbly" heart, which takes a step forwards and then one backwards? Do I love the Lord a bit and the world a bit, or is my heart steadfast in God?

I am here, along with parishioners who will be involved in parish activities this Lent, to walk with you, guide you, minister to you, and share your insights and faith during this Lenten Season. So few people received ashes last year and many felt disconnected from the Lenten Life of the parish. 


as you come to know and love him in an ever-

Lenten Family Activity

- Make a crown of thorns using 2 cups flour, ½ cup salt, 1 cup water - mix well, separate the dough into three portions, roll each into a rope, braid the three rolls into a circle, insert 40 toothpicks into the circle, bake for about 1 hour at 300 degrees
- Every time, your family does an act of charity, prays together, fasts, etc., place a silk flower on one of the toothpicks
- The crown of thorns will be transformed into a wreath of flowers by Easter

communities to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ and respond to real and pressing needs on the ground. Please be generous and join us in our Mission to the Missions!


