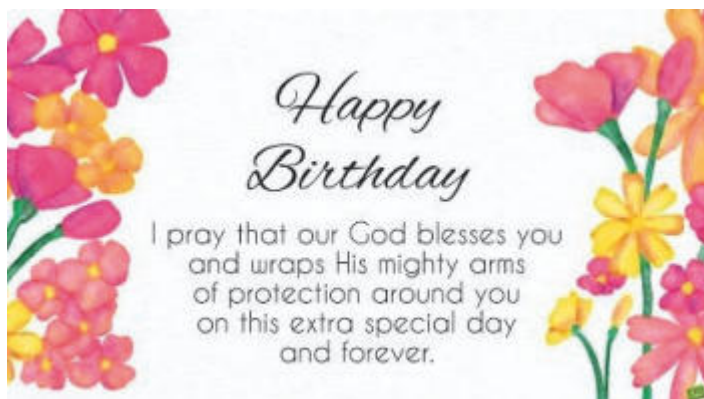
YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH

We will pray with you to St. Joseph for your father, so that your father will be remembered in a special way by bringing him to Mass with you.



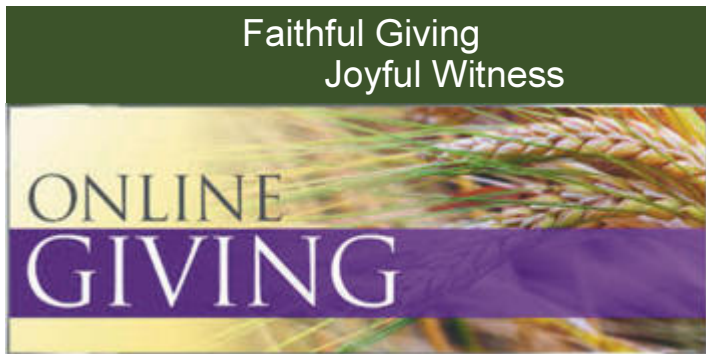

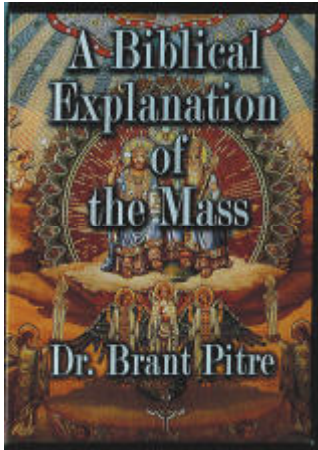
