Interactive Workshop: HEALING OILS OF THE BIBLE

Today at 1pm is St. Joseph's Hall, a special interactive workshop, on the Healing Oils of The Bible, will be presented by Michael Pitek.

Pitek will cover 10 significant oils that are mentioned in the Bible: Aloes/Sacred Sandalwood, Cassia, Frankincense, Myrrh, Myrtle, Cedar/Cedarwood, Cypress, Hyssop, Onycha, and Rose of Sharon/Cistus. Participants will learn the historical and Biblical significance of each oil; discover where these oils are mentioned in Scripture; understand the medicinal properties and medicinal uses of each oil; interact with the oils on olfactory and tactile sensory levels; and discover how the oils can be used in our lives today to enhance one's personal health and sense of wellbeing.

In addition to the educational take-aways listed above, participants will receive DIY oil recipes for everyday use. Special giveaways will also occur
