They are asked to attend the Sunday religious education classes, with their public school counterparts, for specific sacramental preparation classes. Please check the bulletin during the summer for further information, and for registration notices.

I wanted to take a little space to share with you some Road to Renewal updates.


As you may have noticed in our bulletin, our family is looking for a name. Take some time to think and pray about what we should call our family. Details are inside the bulletin.

This week all priests in our Diocese received a video message from Bishop Mike that the work of the Renewal continues and is moving forward. As you should know by now, the Renewal is taking our Diocese's 161 parishes and putting them into 36 Families of Parishes. Our own Family will have 6 parishes that will be led by 1 pastor with 2 parochial vicars (assistants). All 36 families were shared with their data with all priests this week, so priests now have the opportunity to apply to become the Pastor of a Family of Parishes. This begins the process for our own Family here in finding a Pastor for the future. Please pray that the Holy Spirit guides the right priest to apply and lead this family.

Each week I will continue to share more on the Renewal, as our Family of parishes looks to begin working closer together very soon, even collaborating on our mass times. More details to come.
