



As you are already aware, our parishes are part of a pilot in the Renewal. Our committees continue to meet and are helping to form our family action plan. This plan will be what guides all of our communities as we come together as a family. This plan will be essential in helping determine how we move forward as a family. There are currently six areas or 'pillars' that are being addressed to be part of this action plan. For the success of our family, this plan must be comprehensive and bold in how it meets the needs of our communities. One of the first major changes that will be experienced by everyone is the change in our family mass schedule. Three priests will be ministering to our family of parishes and the Bishop along with the Presbyteral Council (the Bishop's consultative group) have made it clear that for the health and well being of our priests, each priest should say three weekend masses for the Sunday obligation. This means that our family of parishes will have nine weekend masses to choose from. Beginning July 1, our family will adopt the new family mass schedule. Next week, this new mass schedule will be shared with all of the parishes in our family. We will be sure that this will be shared for several weeks so everyone knows of the changes moving forward.

Remember, for anyone who attends mass at a parish within our family, as long as you use your parish envelope, the donation goes back to the parish you are registered at.

Please continue to pray for the Renewal and its success. Remember, this is about revitalizing, reenergizing and working together so that we can make our parishes strong and vibrant. Most importantly, this needs all of us to be informed and ready to respond to the needs of our parishes if we want to make sure our parishes survive for the future.

SICK CALLS: Phone rectory immediately in case of serious illness or accident. Also please let us know if you are confined at home and would like Communion brought to you.

MARRIAGES: Arrangements should be made at least six months in advance at the rectory. Attendance at Pre-Cana or Engaged Encounter is required.

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION: If you are asked to be a Godparent, please call the rectory for your letter of recommendation, which attests that you are Baptized, Confirmed, and, if married, married in the Church. Of course your weekly presence at Mass here is vital to being a good role model as Godparent.

BAPTISMS: Please call the rectory to schedule your pre-Baptismal Class. Baptisms are normally celebrated on Sundays at 12:15pm, or during one of the weekend Masses.

CONFESSIONS: Every Saturday beginning at 3:15p.m. (Holy Spirit Church)

Every Sunday following 8:00 a.m. Mass. (St. Margaret Church)
