

APRIL IS ABOUT... PROBLEM SOLVING

Problem Solving is like a muscle that we can grow bigger with practice. Try to allow your child(ren) the opportunity to solve their own dilemmas.

How can we problem solve at school?

- Remind students of the power of yet when they are stuck on a problem. You just haven't figured it out yet!
- Remind students to ask questions when faced with a problem. This will wake up your thinking brain
- Remind students to set small goals in order to reach a larger one. Take the problem one step at a time.

How can we problem solve at home?

- Talking through questions they can ask themselves
- Reminding them the of the power of yet
- Giving them time, space, and confidence to solve it on their own.

Activities: Practice mental challenges at home on building problem solving skills and work on communication with others when solving a problem.
