

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

We enter into the central mystery of our Christian faith and life this weekend as we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity**. The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* (#234) tells us that the Most Holy Trinity "is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the 'hierarchy of the truths of faith.'" **All of salvation history concerns itself with God revealing himself to humanity as Father, Son and Holy Spirit.** Throughout the centuries we have sought to understand this mystery more deeply, using various symbols from the three leafed shamrock to the triangle and many others. There is only one wholly unified God, revealed to us as a trinity of three persons.

This week is the last week of School at Queen of Heaven. On Monday, June 13, we have our final School Mass followed by a special awards ceremony for all of our students in 1st through 8th grade. On the following day (Tuesday, June 14) the students come in for a short prayer service and to receive their Report Cards. Then, they go home, beginning their summer vacation that morning at 10:00 a.m. Later that evening, we celebrate the Graduation Mass and Commencement Ceremonies for our 8th Graders starting at 6:00 p.m. The following day is the last day for the teachers. We certainly will miss having our students and teachers here each day, and we wish them a fruitful and blessed summer vacation. Our prayers are with them for a safe summer and a special time of rest and renewal. I also remind everyone that while **Summer is a time of vacation** from School, it is never a break from taking time to pray and to worship our God. Not all of our students are from our Parish, and we hope that all are able to make it to Church over the summer, whether it is here at Queen of Heaven or their own Parish.

It is hard to believe that final Carnival preparations have begun and that all systems are gearing up for our 2022 Carnival. Initial set-up will be this coming Thursday, June 16, and the actual event is July 7, 8, 9 & 10, less than a month away. With all of this in mind, I want to remind everyone of our need for volunteers. The Carnival Committee has been working all year round to prepare for the event, but we still need the help of many more volunteers to make it successful. The easiest way to sign up to volunteer at the Carnival or to help with setup is to use **our volunteer** portal found at qofhcarnival.com. You could also fill out the volunteer form found elsewhere in the bulletin and drop it in the collection, or call the Rectory to leave your name and contact information. In addition, we need everyone's help in selling tickets for our Cash Sweepstakes, and the time is getting short. Tickets for sweepstakes are available at the doors of the Church and at the Rectory. Thank you to all who have already signed up as volunteers and have sold tickets. We appreciate all of your hard work!



Saint of the Week

St. Germaine Cousins

June 15

Saint Germaine was born in France in 1579 to poor parents. She was born with a deformed right arm and hand, and her mother died when she was an infant. Her father remarried, but her stepmother brutally abused and neglected her. Despite everything, Germaine lived each day tending her flock of sheep with joy and in prayer. Mary and Jesus became her friends. She shared what little she had and taught the children of the village about God's love. A rosary made of string knots was her constant companion. She attended Mass every day, leaving her sheep in care of guardian angels. Her flock was never attacked by wolves and never wandered. Germaine died at 22. her poor body was found by her father, in the barn where she slept. More than forty years later, her body was accidentally exhumed and found to be incorrupt. She was canonized by Pope Pius IX in 1867. **©LPi**


