

# From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate the **Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**. While we have been in Ordinary Time since Pentecost, the past two Sundays we celebrated two Solemnities, i.e. The Most Holy Trinity and The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Now, we are truly in ordinary time, and we will not celebrate another Sunday Solemnity until the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe on November 20th, which is 22 weeks away. This week our readings remind us of our need to be dedicated in following our call to discipleship. We cannot pursue the ways of the world while being dedicated to following Jesus. In our second reading, St. Paul reminds us that Jesus has set us free to follow his ways and warns us not to use our freedom "as an opportunity for the flesh; rather, serve one another through love. For the whole law is fulfilled in one statement, namely, You shall love your neighbor as yourself." May our journey through these weeks of Ordinary Time strengthen our commitment to following Jesus' call to love one another more fully!

In case you have not noticed, the preparations for the 41st Queen of **Heaven Carnival** are in full swing. School is over, and the booths and tents are being erected on the grounds. Final lists and schedules of volunteers are being assembled, and we are moving at a hectic pace as our kickoff is less than two weeks away. The 2022 Carnival runs from July 7 until July 10 starting with Cruz night on Thursday and ending Sunday evening. It is important to note that the Carnival will only be a success with the work of many hands pulling together. There is a critical need for volunteers to help in many areas, and I encourage everyone to sign up to help by going on line at http://www.qofhcarnival.com. Check the carnival website for schedules and more information on what is happening during our carnival days. All hands need to be on deck for us to pull it off successfully. In addition, we need everyone's help in selling tickets for our Cash Sweepstakes, and the time is getting short. Tickets for sweepstakes are available at the doors of the Church and at the Rectory. Most importantly, pray for good weather and a safe time for all of our guests to help make the event a huge success. Much work goes into our preparations, but we will only have a prosperous outcome with God's help.

Lastly, I would like to give an update on our 2022 annual Catholic Charities Appeal. 405 donors from Queen of Heaven have generously given \$117,708.86 which is wonderful. However, it still is \$19,702.14 short of our 2022 goal of \$137,411. I understand that many have given what they are able, and I thank them for this. I would also like to remind everyone else that it still is not too late to contribute to the 2022 appeal which ends this Thursday, June 30. It would be great if we could reach our goal so that Catholic Charities is better able to continue to serve all those in need.


