From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

It is hard to believe that July is already here, and there is so much to make ready. I look forward each year to celebrating Independence Day with our Parish Family at morning Mass and to gather, together with my birth family, at a wonderful celebration later in the day at my sister's family home in Holland, N.Y. I thank God for the privilege of being able to experience the freedom and opportunities that we are fortunate to have in our country, due to the sacrifices of so many who have gone before us. I wish all a blessed 4 th of July and hope that you have a safe and holy holiday! Do not forget that we do have two Masses on July 4 at Queen of Heaven as we do on most weekdays. They are at 7:30 and 11:30 a.m. Is there a better way to start celebrating the day of our nation's birth than coming to give thanks to God at Eucharist?

On June 24 the U.S. Supreme Court issued its decision on the Dobbs v. Jackson case, nullifying the Roe v. Wade judgment from 1973, and our New York State Catholic Bishops issued a statement giving thanks to God for this decision. I join the bishops in their statement:

With the entire pro-life community, we are overjoyed with this outcome of the Court. However, we acknowledge the wide range of emotions associated with this decision. We call on all Catholics and everyone who supports the right to life for unborn children to be charitable, even as we celebrate an important historical moment and an answer to a prayer. We must remember that this is a judicial victory, not a cultural

one. The culture remains deeply divided on the issue, which will be evidenced by the patchwork of state statutes pertaining to abortion across the country. To change the culture and build a culture of life, we need to enact family-friendly policies that welcome children, support mothers, cherish families and empower them to thrive. We outlined our vision for a pro-life New York in our recent statement, and we rededicate ourselves to helping every expectant mother to carry her baby to term.

The federal law has changed, but abortion will still be easily available in N.Y.S. May we all work together to change people's hearts so that all life is respected from the beginning of life until its natural death.

Yes, Carnival Week is upon us! Our committee has been preparing for months, and the transformation of our grounds is almost complete. The time is here, whether you are ready or not. Cruz Night is already this Thursday, July 7, and then the midway, the rides, dinners, and everything else gets into full swing on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. It is still not too late to volunteer if you are able. Volunteers are still needed on many levels of the Carnival, which only runs as well as it has due to our many volunteers. 

First Reading: Is 66:10-14c

Upon their return from exile in Babylon, the prophet Isaiah speaks of God's restoration of Jerusalem, characterizing Jerusalem as a nurturing mother feeding and loving her child.

Why do you think Isaiah uses such sensuous and bold imagery?

Second Reading: Gal 6:14-18
In his closing remarks to the Galatians,

a clear reference to his own physical sufferings.
Paul's scarred body gave him credibility as an apostle.
How would you demonstrate your credibility as a believer in Jesus?


