



First Sunday of Lent

In today's gospel, Jesus goes out into the desert to face three temptations. We too, face these three temptations. First, he is tempted by the flesh. He responds to the devil's temptation to change stones into bread by saying that "Man does not live on bread alone but by every word that comes forth from the mouth of God. The word nourishes and feeds us within. If we are unfaithful to the word. I believe at times we can become depressed and disheartened spiritually. Indulging in the passions of the flesh cannot fill that void that only the word can. The second temptation is the temptation of the world. The world isn't always bad but if we are too focused on the world and not on God we can become consumed with external beauty, power, wealth and fame. In this life, these things will crumble and fall but God's love is forever. The final temptation is pride or control. Jesus' response to this temptation is "Thou shalt not tempt the Lord your God." It can be a great temptation to try to control our lives, but when we do this we aren't listening to God. We must be open to surprises and trials sometimes. We need to let go and let God. I actually believe although it isn't easy, that when we respond to these three temptations as Jesus does, we will be more joyful and free. The temptations of the flesh, world and control only weigh us down in the long run.
