

A Chalk Blessing for Your Home

It is traditional at, during, and following the celebration of the Epiphany to ask God's blessing on your home and those who live in or visit it during the New Year. To do this, write in chalk above your home's entrance:

20+C+M+B+22

The letters stand for the names of the Magi: Caspar, Melchior and Balthazar. It also signifies the Latin "Christus mansionem benedictat" or "May Christ bless this house." The + signs represent the cross and the numbers 20 and 22 mark the New Year.

It is appropriate to bless your door in January, as "janua" means "door" and the first month signifies the "door" to the New Year.

Chalk and instructions are available at Church entrances. Have a blessed and Happy 2022!
