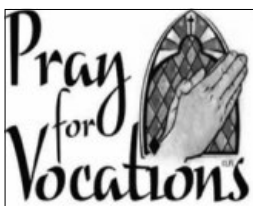

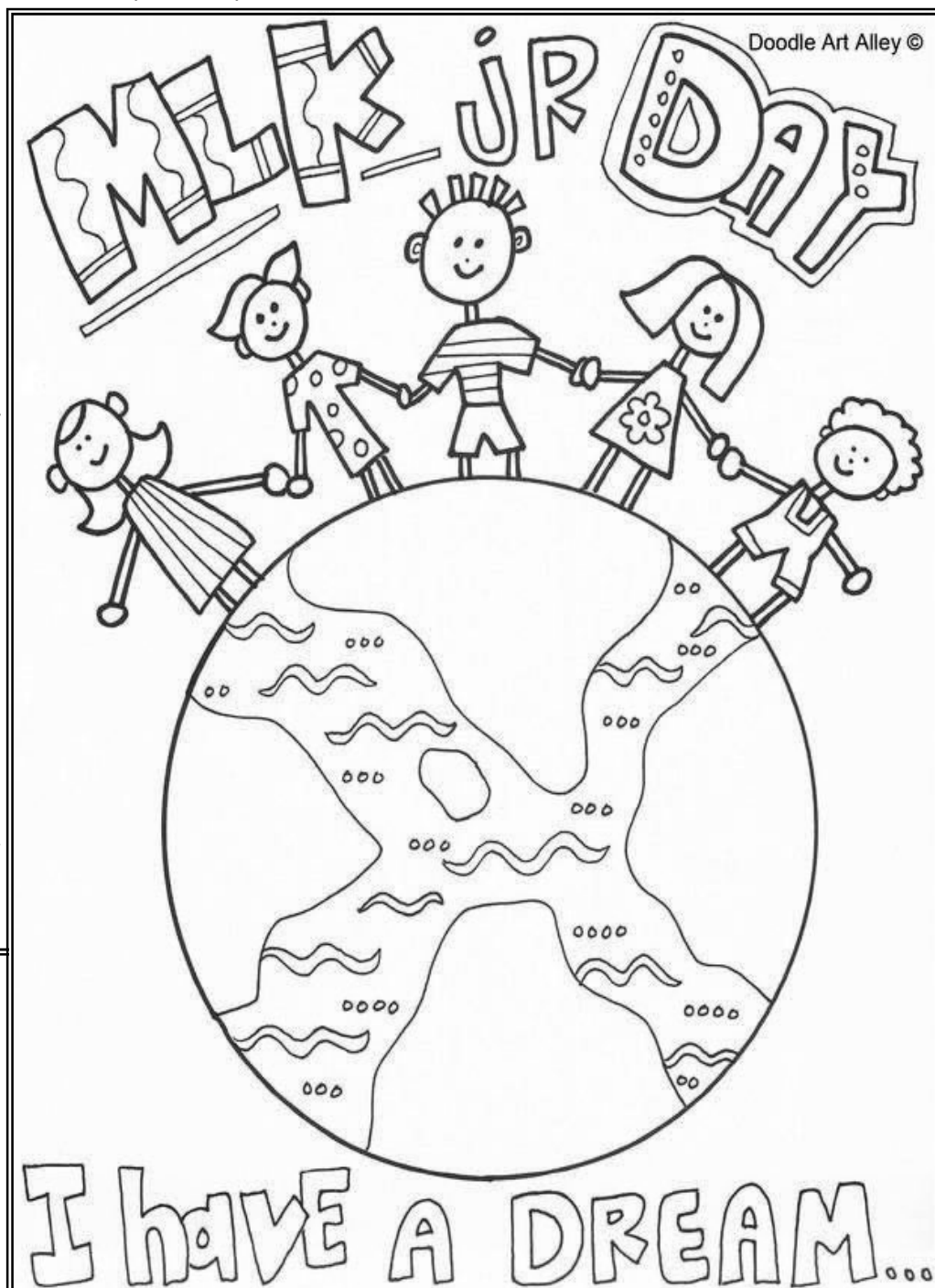
†Martin Luther King Jr
