



FROM THE DEACON'S CHAIR: Indistinctly as in a mirror

I am currently reading a book series (actually, listening to it - cheers to a good audio book!). A little phrase from this series has been lifted and made into stickers, memes, and various other internet side hustles. When I first heard the phrase, I thought it sounded like a winner of a sound bite - a well-turned phrase. It was quaint, memorable, cute but unfortunately wrong. The phrase is "Love at its root is hope."

To be fair, I have not finished the series. I am holding out hope (pun intended) that the author shows how hope cannot be the root of love. Rather, as we know from scripture and our Christian life - it is love that is the root of hope. Her phrase mimics Saint Paul's words, making it sound right, maybe giving it shades of truth, enough to lure a mind. So much in our world does that - reflecting shades of truth but not the fullness of revealed truth. Maybe they reveal just enough to make us feel self-righteous and satisfied like the modern commandment to "offend no one." Maybe they grab our attention and distract us from our goal like "click-bait". Maybe they dull our appetite for substances like sugar-infused fast food.

We all need to be careful consumers. The devil is in the details, but God was there first. "At present we see indistinctly, as in a mirror, but then face to face. At present I know partially; then I shall know fully, as I am fully known. So faith, hope, love remain, these three; but the greatest of these is love." 1 Cor 13:12-13
