The other day a friend of mine told me that Flannery O'Connor said that we do not *join* the Catholic Church rather we *become* Catholic. Since we are only a few weeks removed from welcoming a host of new Catholics, inviting our youngest members to receive Jesus in the Eucharistic for the first time, and only a few days past our young people receiving the grace of Confirmation, I thought the quote was well timed.

Conversion is less about joining than being, less about belonging and then becoming. That explains the joy of being around a new convert. We remember (consciously or not) the energy of being made new. It's a feeling of optimism and freshness that is exciting and contagious. It is reflected in the heartfelt but airy feeling of being forgiven, walking a little lighter while stepping out of a confessional. 


