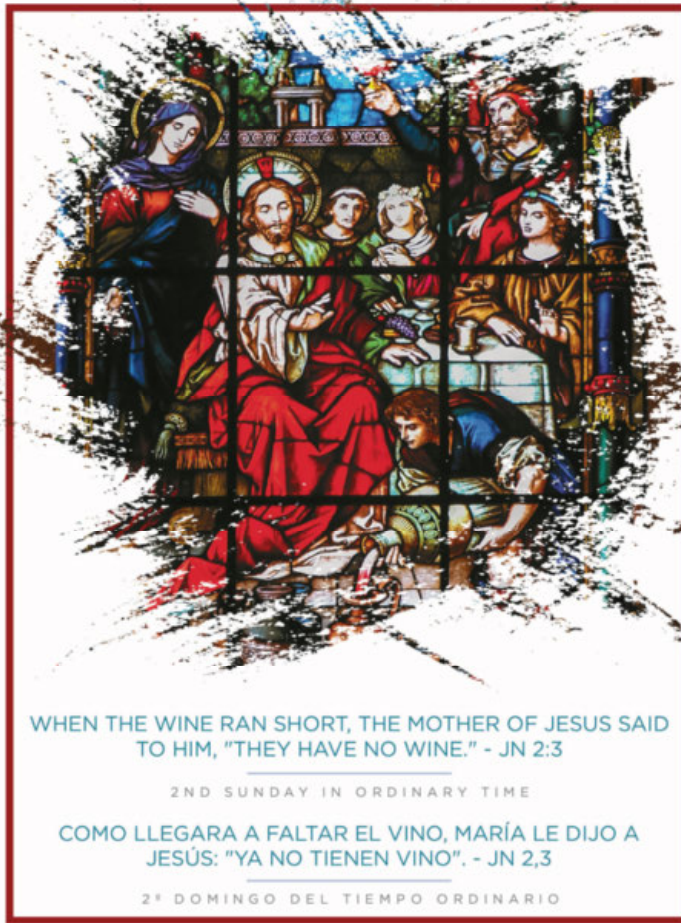

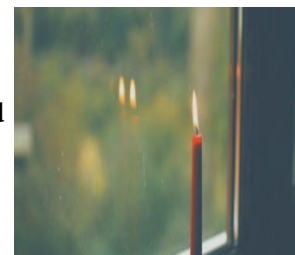

PRO-LIFE NEWS:

Saturday, January 22, will be the 49th anniversary of the Supreme Court Roe v Wade decision legalizing abortion in America, with the resulting horror of the death of over 60 million unborn babies. Please consider observing January 22 as a day of prayer and sacrifice that this year will realize the overturn of Roe v Wade and the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life of the unborn. This could include the Rosary, fasting, Chaplet of Divine Mercy, an act of kindness, etc. And please remember to pray for the Supreme Court in this decisive ruling.

Candle In The Window:

On the evening of January 22nd parishioners are invited to join with others around the nation for “Candle In The Window”--a simple witness of placing a light in the front window of one’s home as a memorial to the unborn. For decades this simple gesture has served to remind us to pray for unborn children and remember the millions lost in the wake of the Roe vs. Wade Supreme Court decision handed down on that date in 1973. For those who don’t have a flameless candle, battery candles are available at the information tables in the church--donations are optional but gratefully accepted.

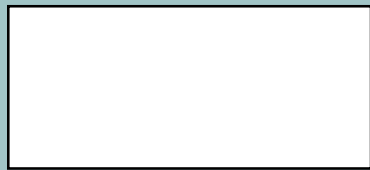

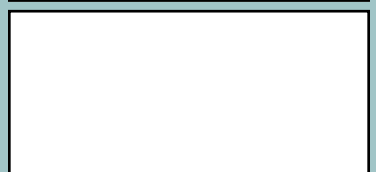
