

MESSAGE FROM FR. JIM

Dear Parishioners.

Over the last nine months or so I have spoken about us starting the Road to Renewal process in October. However, things have changed in the diocese. The bishop and the diocesan Renewal team has decided to take a little bit of a different approach. The Renewal will now be done by vicariate. A vicariate is basically a subdivision of the diocese, a group of parishes in localities. We were previously in the Western Niagara Vicariate. We will now be in the Northern Erie Vicariate because the parishes in our family are mostly in Northern Erie County.

Also, the diocese is going from a three-year renewal plan to one that is a year and a half, three phases to two phases. The Renewal team has studied this extensively and has concluded that it is better to get it done more quickly than not. Around 66% of the dioceses in the country either have done or are currently doing something similar to what we are doing here in Buffalo, so the diocese has plenty of data to go by.

What does that mean for us here at St Jude? We will no longer begin the process next month. We will not be starting until May of 2023. The entire Northern Erie Vicariate will start next May.

This has been a bit of a shock to the priests of the diocese and their parishes. Some parishes had planned to start in phase three are now starting next week. Some who planned to start next week will not be starting until next year. Please continue to pray for the Road to Renewal. Times are changing here in the diocese. Let us pray that this will provide the change we need.

By freely choosing this gift, you invite the God of the Universe to descend from His Throne of Grace and embrace you with an embrace of pure love, enabling you to offer that embrace to others.

ROAD TO RENEWAL UPDATES—TWO PHASES

As we continue the *Road to Renewal*, the remaining families will be designated to be formed within two Phases. Each phase will consist of the following stages:

- Activation Stage—Parishes begin developing a Family Council and Family Action Plan. This phase lasts six months.
 - * Phase 1—Family of Parishes will commence this stage October 1, 2022
 - *Phase 2—Family of Parishes will commence this stage May 1, 2023
- Inauguration Stage—The date on which a Family of Parishes begins functioning as a Family
 - * Phase 1—Family of Parishes are estimated to be inaugurated May 1, 2023
 - * Phase 2—Family of Parishes are estimated to be inaugurated by November 1, 2023
