**MESSAGE FROM FR. JIM**

Dear Parishioners,

Advent starts in a few short weeks. As we know, it is the preparation time for Christmas. Keep in mind that it is also a season in and of itself. Due to our culture, we could easily lose track of the fact that Advent is not Christmas.

When we begin Advent, I would like you to try several things. Remember that it is a time of prayer and reflection. Dedicate the season to deepening your prayer life. This can happen by reflecting on the daily readings, taking a look at daily reflections, and spending some time in eucharistic adoration. Another thing I would suggest is to go to confession. Advent is a time of reflection and repentance. Give yourself the opportunity to remove the weight of sin that might be dragging you down.

Finally, getting into the Christmas spirit is fine. There is nothing wrong with it. However, the commercialism of the time can easily result in us losing track of the meaning of both Advent and Christmas. Remind yourself to take a break from the business of the time for family and prayer.

**Mary is the mother of the Church Suffering:** If the Blessed Virgin Mary is not only mother of the physical Christ but also the mother of the mystical body of Christ, then it follows she is the Mother of Christians on earth, in Heaven, and in Purgatory. The first two are sometimes referred to as the Church Militant and Church Triumphant. The souls in Purgatory are referred to as the Church Suffering. Therefore, we can say that Mary is the mother of the Church Suffering. We have the marvelous certainty that “Mary is ever pleading for the Holy Souls in Purgatory and that her intercession merits more than that of all the saints and angels taken together” (Drinan R., “Mother of the Church Suffering.” Ave Maria Magazine, Vol. 70, Oct. 29, 1949, pg. 551)

Things to do During Eucharistic Adoration:



5. **Pour out your heart to Christ and adore Him.** Speak to Jesus, aware that you are in His presence, and tell Him all that comes to your mind. Listen for His response. Pray the prayer that St. Francis instructed his brothers to pray whenever they were before the Blessed Sacrament: “I adore you, O Christ, present here and in all the churches of the world, for by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.”
6. **Ask for forgiveness and intercede for others.** Think of those who have hurt you and request a special blessing for them. Ask God to forgive you for all the times you have neglected or hurt someone else. Bring before the Blessed Sacrament all those who have asked you to pray for them. Ask the Lord to address their concerns.
