EPIPHANY OF THE LORD - JANUARY 5, 2025

Dear Friends,

Until 1822, we had absolutely no idea what happened to birds in the winter. All we knew were there were birds in the summer and no birds in the winter. And people developed a lot of crazy theories about what would happen to the birds every fall. Some people said they would dive into lakes and hibernate under the ice. Some people thought they would burrow into the ground to hibernate while other people said the birds would transition themselves into other animals, like mice and rabbits in the winter, and then would transition themselves back into birds in the spring.

A Harvard educator name Charles Morton did propose migration in 1694, but he believed birds migrated to the moon and back. Then in 1822 a German Hunter was out looking for dinner near the town of Klutz when he shot and killed a white stork. But when he picked up the bird he found it already had a 30-inch spear in its neck. Finding this interesting, the hunter brought his kill to the nearby University of Rostock, where scientists found the iron-tipped wood spear to be of Central African origin. This proved without a doubt the stork had migrated between Europe and Africa and led scientists down the right path to discover that birds migrate to warmer climates in the winter.

In the city of Lima and the great state of Ohio, we have a number of birds who head south during the cold days of winter – snow birds. Oh are they fortunate! On January 2 each year I would pack my parents car and take them to St. Pete Beach, Florida where they would remain for three months until some real birds who had migrated south returned to our area and once again started chirping. Because we wanted to waste no time on the highway, mom and dad would eagerly await arriving in Valdosta, Georgia on the first leg of the trip. Then early the next day we would grab a bite to eat and by noon be in the condo they had rented in the wonderful climes of the sunshine state. My parents wasted no time in sitting on the balcony of the condo surveying the gulf, while I walked the beach for about two miles south to get some exercise. In the evening we would all toast the sunset and then, after a nice meal once again enjoy the warmth while relating stories of family life in years gone by.

Even though my parents may have gone to another location for the winter, the one constant was their desire to go to weekend Mass at St. John Church. Oh my, was every liturgy ever crowded! In fact, the parish had to hire police officers to direct traffic so that Mass attendees could make it in and out of the church parking lot safely. When I visited them every month to prepare and freeze food for them for the next 30 days (and, of course, enjoy the sun), I often wished that we would have to hire officers in Lima to guide parishioners and visitors into our parking lots for weekend liturgies. Here's my point, folks: if we travel south this winter (or summer) or north or east or west, let's make it a point to seek out a parish community where Mass is being celebrated. My parents always took comfort in the fact that into every Catholic church they went they could always enjoy the same celebration of the Eucharist. As I write this, it's 70 degrees in St. Pete Beach! Oh happy days!

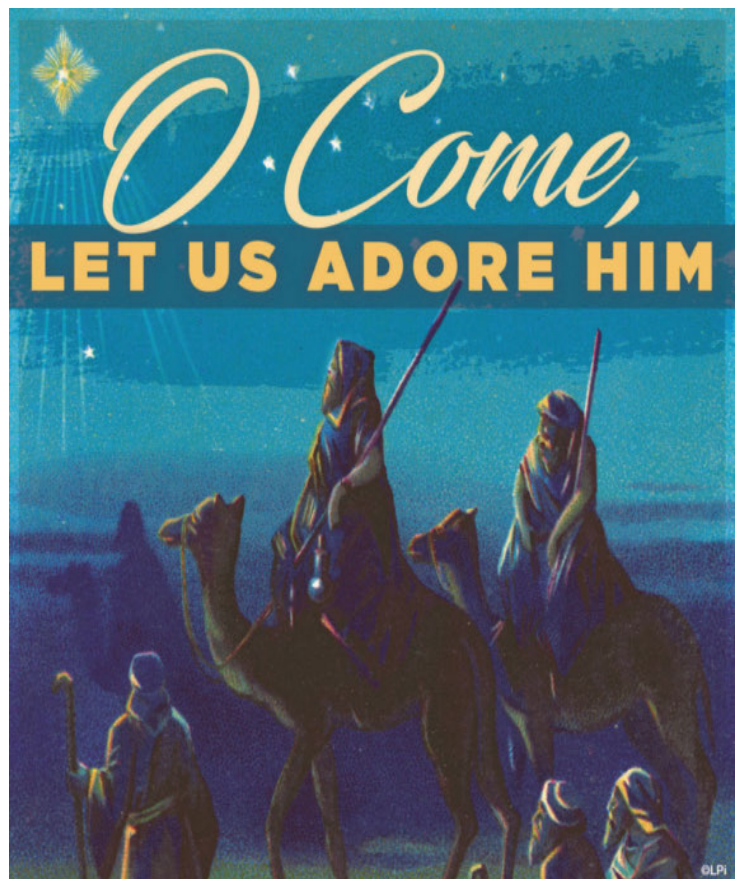

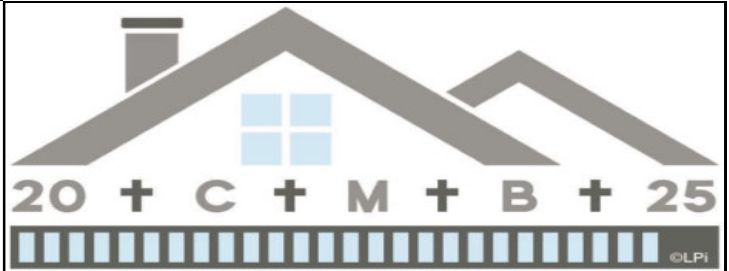

The Epiphany household blessing is an ancient practice in the Church. This tradition is a beautiful way to observe the coming of the magi while invoking God's blessing on your home and all who enter it. All that is needed is chalk and a prayerful heart!

There are a few different formulas for blessings out there, but the essence of the ritual is always the same: a priest or the head of the household calls down God's blessing on the house and everyone who comes into it, and an inscription is made above the door in chalk.

The inscription reads: the first two digits of the year + C + M + B + the last two digits of the year. The initials C, M and B represent the names of the magi — Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar — and also signify the Latin phrase *Christus mansionem benedicat*: "May Christ bless the house."
