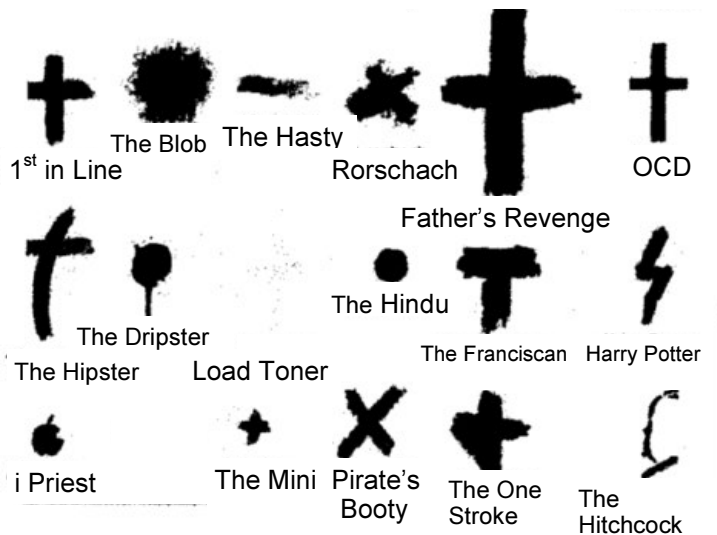

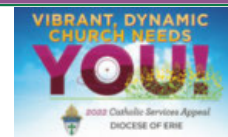
March 6 - Hair Care Week - shampoo; conditioner; combs; hair brushes; hair clips; barrettes.
