Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments

April is Child Abuse Prevention Month: Recent statistics tell us one out of every four girls and one out of every 6 boys are sexually abused before they turn 18. 91% of sexual abuse is perpetrated by someone the child or the child's family knows.
