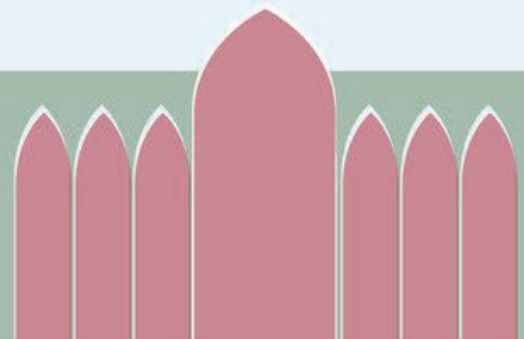

DAY of FASTING and ABSTINENCE



Also, please remember that Good Friday is a day of abstinence from meat for any Catholic Christian age 14 and onward. Additionally, it is one of two days of fast for Catholics who are between the ages of 18-59, meaning, according to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, "that a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal." The American bishops also remind us that "if possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the 'paschal fast' to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection."

Finally, the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord – celebrating the wonder of the Word made flesh when the Blessed Virgin Mary consented to participating with God's saving Will – that is normally celebrated nine months from Christmas Day, on March 25, is postponed this year until Monday, April 8 (Eclipse Day) since March 25 is Monday of Holy Week, and the Octave of Easter follows. You'll be happy to know, however, that Christmas will remain on December 25!

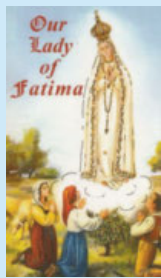

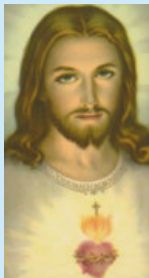

Finance Council

Existing to fulfill the requirements of Canon 537 in the 1983 *Code of Canon Law*, diocesan statutes explain that "the Finance Council exists to assist the pastor in the administration of the goods of the parish." As the finances of each parish are separate, each parish has its own Finance Council, which advises the pastor of the parishes on a regular basis. Saint Jerome members are: Robin Kamann, Jeff Luoma, Julie Pinciotti, Charles Rupp (chair), and Sue Trumbull. The pastoral associate for administration at All Saints and the parish manager at Saint Jerome are *ex officio* members of the respective finance councils.

ASCS Endowment Fund Committee

An endowment fund was created years ago for the benefit of the sustainability of All Saints Catholic School, and is overseen by an Endowment Fund Committee, currently consisting of: Kevin Heban, Alan Sattler, Norb Trojanowski, and Jeff Yost, with the pastor and pastoral associate for administration as *ex officio* members.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

◆ Sacrament of Baptism

Please contact either parish office for information and to schedule, which for first-time parents includes an orientation to the sacrament.

◆ Sacrament of Confirmation

The normative time for Confirmation in the Diocese of Toledo is eighth grade. Please contact Sue VanHersett at All Saints or Sr. Tina Petrick at Saint Jerome for more information.

◆ Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession)

A priest is available on Tuesdays, from 5:05-5:45 p.m. at Saint Jerome, and on Saturdays, from 3:30-4:00 p.m. at All Saints and Saint Jerome. Please consult the bulletin for additionally scheduled opportunities throughout the year.

◆ Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

Formerly known as *Extreme Unction* or the "Last Rites," the Anointing of the Sick can be received many times throughout one's life, and is not reserved for the end of life only. Please contact either parish office if you or a family member are critically ill, preparing for surgery, or are of advanced age and in need of this sacrament. In case of an emergency outside of office hours, please follow the automated prompts to reach the Pastoral Emergency Line. Please do not leave a message on Fr. Scott or Fr. Michael's personal voice mail in case of an emergency, though you may do so on the Pastoral Emergency Line.

◆ Holy Communion for the Homebound

Please contact either parish office if you are unable to come to the Lord's Day Mass (Saturday evening or Sunday) and would like an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion to bring the Eucharist to you in your home or care facility.

◆ Sacrament of Matrimony

Please contact either parish office at least six months before you hope to marry, and know that a wedding date cannot be set until a couple's freedom to marry has been determined. Annulments, for those who were previously married, may require 18-24 months to resolve, and a wedding cannot be scheduled until a decree of nullity is provided by the Diocesan Tribunal.

◆ Sacrament of Holy Orders and Religious Life

Please contact Fr. Scott, Fr. Michael, or Sr. Tina if you feel the Lord may be inviting you to consider a vocation to the priesthood, the diaconate, or the religious life.

Easter Baskets for Blessing

Blessing of the Easter Food Baskets on Holy Saturday morning is a tradition among Roman Catholics and Eastern Europeans. While tastes vary by region and family, the basket usually contains smoked meats, sausage, butter, cheese, bread, salt, cake, eggs and a candle. However, any food items can be included in the basket.

- Smoked Meats—Symbolic of God's favor and generosity.
- Ham—Symbolic of great joy and abundance. Some prefer lamb or veal, which reminds Christians that the Risen Christ is the Lamb of God.
- Bacon— is a symbol of the overabundance of God's mercy and generosity.
- Salt— a necessary element in physical life—is symbolic of prosperity and justice to remind us that people are the flavor of the earth.
- Cheese— Symbolic of the moderation Christians should have at all times.
- Eggs—Symbols of Easter, life, and prosperity and Christ's resurrection from the tomb.
- Butter—Symbolic of the goodness of Christ, that we should emulate towards others.
- Bread—A symbol of Jesus Christ, the Bread of Life.
- Horseradish (mixed with beets)— Symbolic of the Christ's passion and blood he shed.
- Candle—Symbolizes Jesus, the Light of the World.

Blessed food is shared with family members after Mass on Easter Sunday.
