

Preparing for Beacons of Lite-Phase 1 Beginning July 1, 2022

As many are aware, our Archdiocese has been going through a process called the Beacons of Light. This planning process is meant to help to study every aspect of the archdiocese and parishes to determine how to best utilize our resources – human, physical and financial – to spread the Gospel far and wide.

Everyone wants to belong to a vibrant parish right? Well. the goal as we move through this multi-year process is to ensure that our parishes are strong and vibrant and effective in spreading the Gospel message for decades and even centuries to come.

While several years of work have already been happening, things really start taking effect July 1, 2022, when Father Jarred Kohn becomes the pastor of Holy Angels parish in Sidney, Sacred Heart of Jesus parish in McCartyville, Ss. Peter & Paul parish in Newport and St. Michael parish in Fort Loramie. Father Jarred will be assisted by three parochial vicars (kind of like assistant priests) Father Aaron Hess, Father Steve Mondiek and Father Andrew Reckers. These four priests will be rotating between the four parishes on a weekly basis beginning July 1. We might say that July 1 is where the rubber meets the road.

As we transition through this period, you will notice a few changes in our Newport-Fort Loramie Pastoral Region.

Beginning June 6, 2022, the following changes will take place....

- Ss. Peter & Paul 8:00 am daily Mass will move to Monday mornings.
- Tuesday afternoon confessions will be moved from Ss. Peter & Paul to St. Michael Chapel from 5:00-5:30 pm
- Tuesday evening Mass at St. Michael will begin at 6:00 pm.

Beginning July 1, 2022

 Confessions will be offered in St. Michael Chapel from 10:15-10:45 am on Sunday mornings.


