#### **Lines of Communication**

As Beacons of Light begins in earnest we are working towards making things work as best we can. I am writing this before Beacons has kicked off. Because of the July 4<sup>th</sup> Holiday (Happy Birthday America!) we have to submit our bulletins early. Thus, I apologize if any balls have been dropped and confusion has ensued. But please understand that I have 4 parishes to pastor and that our offices now have 4 priests to keep track of. No easy task for anyone.

We have come to a solution for how parishioners will reach priests for Sacramental Emergencies after hours, allowing those who need Last Rites to receive it in a timely manner. What is a sacramental emergency? A sacramental emergency is a life-or-death situation that poses an imminent threat to life or lives which requires Last Rites (apostolic pardon, anointing, and if the individual is able viaticum [aka Holy Communion]). Calling this line is for real emergencies and not for requests, questions, or complaints. It is used to ensure that someone in need of the Lord's mercy and grace at the time of death can receive this gift through the ministry of a priest. This is one of the great gifts of being a priest, to help someone to trust in Jesus through the sacraments of the Church!

The emergency line number is (937) 947-0204, and you will also be able to call each parish office after hours and be given an extension option that will reach this number as well. When the emergency line is called, it will ring to each of the four priests' phones (Fr. Steve Mondiek, Fr. Andrew Reckers, Fr. Jarred Kohn, and Fr. Aaron Hess) and whoever picks up first will take the call. If the call goes to voicemail, each priest will be able to access the voicemail on his phone and will respond as quickly as possible. Again, this number is for sacramental emergencies only! I would suggest you put the above number in your phone in case it is needed. It would also be a good idea to call your respective parish office when a loved one's health takes a turn for the worse before it is an emergency. This also allows the loved one to prepare. I tell you all of this because I want everyone to be able to receive all the grace they can to face their death and come to the heavenly homeland. We want to get everyone to heaven!

Another communication note, if you visit another parish within our Family of Parishes (St. Michael, Fort Loramie; Sacred Heart, McCartyville; Holy Angels, Sidney; and Ss. Peter & Paul, Newport) for Sunday Mass, you will be able to drop your collection envelope into the collection basket and each of our parish offices will ensure that your envelope and contribution gets back to your home parish. Thank you for everyone's generosity and for the excellent work all our volunteers do. I am always impressed by how much happens without me knowing because people just do what they need to do to help their parish. It is a beautiful testament to your love for our Lord. Finally, a big ole THANK YOU! to my staff at Ss. Peter & Paul, St. Michael, Sacred Heart, and Holy Angels for putting up with me. I cannot imagine how hard it is for them to share a pastor, but they do it with patience and grace. They are great! Thank them for the service they give to your parish.



#### PAGE 5 VICAR'S CORNER

We are all very familiar with the parable of the Good Samaritan. In this parable, Our Lord says, "go and do likewise." It seems very clear that we are to love our neighbor as ourselves. This follows from Our Lord giving us the commandment to love God and neighbor...and these are the most important. But the Early Church Fathers saw this parable in another way as well. The Good Samaritan is above all, a self-portrait of Jesus and what he has done for all of us. All of us are like the poor man who fell ill with the robbers and was left on the side of the road. Each of us has been robbed of our original holiness by original sin. Our own personal sin has deeply wounded our souls. All of us lay on the side of the road in need of a Savior. Think of how so many things deeply bruise and wound us. But Our Lord came that we might have 'life and have it to the full.' Our Lord is kind and merciful who heals us mainly through a life centered on the Sacraments. Christ paid for our salvation by his sacrifice on Good Friday. And that redemptive act paved the way for the Church to be the great steward of grace. If Jesus commands us to be Good Samaritans to one another, it's only because he has walked the path ahead of us. Our Lord has never stopped telling the world that he wants to be its Good Samaritan, that his commandments and Sacraments are the healing ointment for our wounds of selfishness and sin. Throughout the centuries he has expressed this message in many ways trying to convince how much he really loves us. In the 17th century, he communicated this message to the world in a series of visions that he gave to St Margaret Mary Alacoque, a humble French nun. These visions were the beginning of the famous devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. When he first appeared to St Margaret Mary, he stood in front of her and showed her his heart, describing it as a furnace of love. Then he reached out and took her heart in his hands. She saw her heart as if it were a tiny little atom. Our Lord put it inside his own heart, where it caught fire and started to burn with the flames of his love. On another occasion, he allowed her to look directly at his heart. She wrote later that it was as bright as the sun and very clear. At the top of the heart was a cross. On one side was a deep gash - the wound he had received on Calvary when the soldiers thrust a spear into his side. Wrapped tightly around the middle of his heart was a ring of thorns. Jesus explained that these thorns were the indifference and ingratitude that he received from the men and women whom he loved, for whom he had died, for whom he had become the world's Good Samaritan. If Christ showed us in many ways how much he loves us, we should also show this love to one another. God bless!

#### SACRAMENTS OF THE CHURCH

#### Sacrament of Baptism (infants)

First time parents are to attend a pre-baptismal program that is offered quarterly throughout the year. Baptisms may be celebrated during any weekend mass. Outside of mass, baptisms are celebrated at St Michael on the 2nd & 4th Sundays at 12:00p. At Ss. Peter & Paul, baptisms are celebrated on the 3rd Sunday at 10:30a. Schedule with the Parish Office Center at least two weeks in advance at 937-295-2891.

#### **Sacrament of Holy Matrimony**

Make an appointment with the pastor, vicars or deacon at least six months in advance of the anticipated wedding date. The church building is not reserved before this meeting. The preparation program consists of meetings with the pastor, FOCCUS and a Pre-Cana workshop. If either party has previously been married, that marriage must be annulled before setting a date. 
