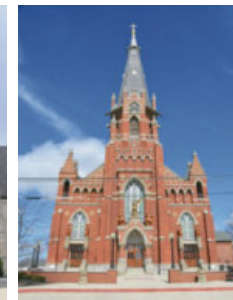

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

The Archdiocese of Cincinnati has a longstanding tradition of offering priests a time of sabbatical consisting of three months after every ten years of active ministry. I was granted a sabbatical in 2015, but chose not to take it as I couldn't imagine being away from family, friends, parishioners, and my Dalmatian Skylar for that long. About six years ago, the Archdiocese changed the policy so priests who are granted a sabbatical can take one month at a time over a period of three years. Before I became pastor at St. Joseph Pillar of Families, Family of Parishes, I applied for and was granted a sabbatical commencing in 2025, as I completed 20 years of ministry on May 21st.

Therefore, I will be on sabbatical this year from September 29th through October 27th, with the exception of the weekend of October 17th-19th as I return home for a wedding. On October 20th, I will depart for St. Louis for a Catholic Leadership Institute program for priests.

For the first three weeks, I will be visiting my classmate, Fr. Chris Luoni, in the Diocese of Youngstown. He has a fenced backyard so I am able to take Maggie and Millie with me.

While I am away, Fr. Mark Bredestege will be the temporary administrator.

The Priests' Personnel Policies state: Sabbaticals offer priests the opportunity to be renewed through a rest, a change of pace, and freedom from the stress of ministry and other concerns. When a priest acquires additional theological understanding, pastoral skills, and personal growth during a sabbatical, there are obvious benefits to the people he serves.

Please pray for me during my time of sabbatical. My hope is to return refreshed, renewed, and relaxed as we continue to journey together in building the Kingdom of God.

ST. PHILOMENA MONTESSORI SCHOOL



CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD AT ST. PHILOMENA MONTESSORI:

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a central component of our school's Catholic identity. A few weeks ago, the children were introduced to their atria, which is a special place set aside and prepared for the development of their relationship with God. The children, without external

prompts from the adult, bask in the JOY of their loving Good Shepherd in the Atria, spontaneously praying and praising God all the while. One of the first presentations a child will receive in the Atrium is the Model Altar. The Model Altar material grows with the child. At the age of three, the child is introduced to the altar, altar cloth, paten, chalice, crucifix, and candles. After many months of enjoying these simple, essential items, the Lectionary and ambo, tabernacle, ciborium, and sanctuary lamp are introduced. When the child has learned the names of all of these items, even more articles are presented. By the end of Level I (CH), many children are able to set out and begin labeling all of the items at the Model Altar.

In the Words of the Children...

4 year old, "Thank you Jesus for this meal" "How beautiful."

5 year old: "Thank you for this great feast."

We ended our Atrium session singing, "Lord Jesus come, Good Shepherd come, the bread is on the table, lead me to you. Lord Jesus come, Good Shepherd come, the wine is on the table, lead me to you."
