

COVID related issues caused us to cancel grade school religious education classes on December 18th. Classes will resume on January 8th.

At Mass a couple of weeks ago, Fr. Bogniak mentioned that our parish has the largest weekend attendance of all the parishes in the Diocese of Erie. Our Lady of Peace came in second. This information comes from

the latest October count. In the diocese, St. James has the largest number of weekend Masses. Two parishes have five weekend Masses; 12 parishes have four. The rest have three or fewer. The total number of parish weekend Masses celebrated throughout the diocese is 249. Of that number, 90 of the



Masses are offered at the churches in Erie County. The statistics also show that every parish, including our own, is experiencing a decline in attendance. One church in the Bradford Deanery reports a weekend attendance of only 4 people. A church in Potter County shows an attendance of 14. I would like to thank our ushers for all their help in making our church a welcoming environment. Visitors may enter our building as strangers, but they leave knowing that they are regarded as friends. I put a link to the October Count report on our parish web page.

Max Benes, an eighth grader at our school, ranked 7th on the Cathedral Prep entrance exam. The test was taken by over 200 students from 30 different schools. He was offered a \$1,000 scholarship which will be renewed each year. Congratulations to Max, his parents, and his teachers.
