



Novena for Life

Our faith calls upon us to pray and act, proclaiming the dignity and value of every human life. In the days leading up to the National March for Life, Saint Mary's will host daily Prayers for Life. All parishioners are welcome to participate in this unique opportunity. The Novena Prayers will happen each day for nine days in a row. This brief service will include Scripture readings and special intercessions. The Novena prayers will take place before or after Mass each day in the Daily Mass Chapel for 30 minutes. The prayers will also be available on line so that you can pray them at home. The schedule is as follows:

Jan. 15 - Novena prayers at 6:30 PM

(DID YOU KNOW? The word "Novena" comes from the Latin word *novem*, which means "nine." It refers to the Catholic practice of joining together for public or devotional prayer for nine days. The practice of Novena prayers is ancient in our faith tradition, and offers a way for Catholics to focus prayerfully on important aspects of the Gospel.)


What is desert spirituality asking of you?

2021 St. Mary's Contribution Statements

Given tax law changes resulting in fewer households itemizing their taxes and in in effort to conserve resources, St. Mary's will not bulk mail 2021 contribution statements. Statements will be available after January 31st, 2022. If you need a contribution statement for your tax filing, there are 4 ways to get a 2021 statement:

- If you contribute via E-Giving you can print a statement from your online E-Giving account at any time. E-Giving account login can be accessed from the St. Mary's website at www.stmarysrichmond.org by clicking on E-Giving.
- 2.) Register for a My Own Church account (MOC). Having a MOC account allows you to edit personal and contact information directly in the parish database. It also allows you to see all your contributions and print a yearend statement. Go to www.stmarysrichmond.org and click on My Own Church. These electronic statements will be available after January 31st, 2022
- For an e-mail copy or paper copy of your 2021 statement you can send a request e-mail to <u>taxstatement@stmarysrichmond.org</u>






