

#### THOUGHTS ON THE WAY UP MOUNT CARMEL

Have you ever considered that when (as this year) the groundhog predicts 6 more weeks of winter that he is only telling us something we already know: that winter officially ends with the Spring Equinox on March 20? That just happens to be 6 weeks from Groundhog Day! So, big deal! But, before we dismiss the prediction too quickly, remember that the groundhog is right nearly 40% of the time. That's about what our meteorologists score on correctness! But, I am ready for winter to end now. As many of you have mentioned to me already.

Lent begins just 2 ½ weeks from this weekend. There are lots of ways to get ready for such an important time, including picking up a copy of our annual Lenten Prayer books which should be available shortly. You could also volunteer a bit of time making pierogi for our Lenten Dinners which are Friday, March 11, 25 and April 11. We are making pierogi every Thursday this month. We begin each time at 9.

On the subject of our dinners, we will have limited indoor dining as well as takeout orders. You do not have to order in advance. Order and pay when you arrive. We will limit our dining to the north half of Scheffner Hall with fewer chairs at each table to permit safer spacing, except for family units. Everyone in the building, including those in the takeout line must be wearing a mask, except when eating. The line for dining orders will be completely in the gym. Only the takeout line will be in the vestibule and hallway. We hope that these measures will help to keep everyone safe, including our volunteers. Our famous volunteer forms will be in our pews the next two weekends. Of course, you can always call or stop by the parish office to volunteer.

Thanks to our group of parishioners who are representing OLMC at the East Erie Deanery Pastoral Planning meetings. From high school students to our most experienced members, they offer their life experience and opinions to chart our way forward as we plan for the future of the church in east Erie County. We already have many cooperative ministries at work on our east side (like our parish Food Pantry and Homeless Ministry) and I know there is much more we can do to spread the Gospel in the future as we share our resources and talents and work together to make our ministry happen.

Please pray for our Second Grade students who will receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (confession) for the first time on Saturday, February 19 and our Confirmation candidates who will receive the Holy Spirit on Thursday, March 24. Congratulations to all our young people who are growing in the faith. In April, our RCIA candidates will be confirmed and complete their reception of the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil on April 16. Just a week later, our First Eucharist students will receive Holy Communion on Sunday, April 24<sup>th</sup> at the 11:00 Mass. Make all of these young people part of your daily prayer intentions. Thank you!

On May 15, in the square of St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, I will attend (along with Fr. John Jacquel and other priests who are part of the Jesus Caritas fraternity) the canonization ceremony of Blessed Charles Foucauld. I have never been to a canonization and very much look forward to it. It will also probably be as close to Pope Francis as I am likely to get! I have been a member of the Fraternity since my retirement from teaching. Each group of priests meets monthly for prayer, support and sharing a meal together. It should be a great visit to Rome. And speaking of Europe, don't forget that there are still spots available for our September group tour to Germany and Austria, including attending the once a decade performance of the Oberammergau Passion Play.
