

THOUGHTS ON THE WAY UP MOUNT CARMEL

Dear Friends:

In just a few days, on **Ash Wednesday,** we will hear the call to conversion and enter the holy **Season of Lent**. We all need this time of prayer – asking the Holy Spirit to help us fashion our lives and hearts more closely to God's will. Traditionally, it is a time for prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. With all this in mind, I exhort you to embrace the grace of Lent and to consider these opportunities:

- Ash Wednesday Masses will be at 7:00 am and 6:00 pm.
- **Days of Abstinence**: Ash Wednesday, All Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday are days of abstinence from eating meat for those 14 years of age and older. [Note: This year, St. Patrick's Day, March 17, falls on a Friday in Lent. In recognition that St. Patrick is the Principal Patron Saint of the Diocese of Erie, Bishop Persico has dispensed all Latin Rite Catholics from the requirement of abstinence from eating meat on March 17, 2023.]
- **Days of Fasting**: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are also days of fasting for those ages 18-58 inclusive.
- **Sacrament of Penance**: In addition to the normal Saturday confession time, Father Cas and I will be available for Confession **after ALL weekend** Masses during Lent. Please take advantage of this great sacrament of Divine Mercy!
- **Daily Mass**: I encourage you to consider attending Mass during the week, here or at any parish. We have 7:00 am Mass at OLMC, Monday through Friday.
- **The Chosen Season Two**: Each Thursday, we watch an episode of the life of Jesus and His disciples and prayerfully discuss. We begin at 6:00 pm in the MPR and conclude by 7:30 pm.
- Fish and Pierogi Dinners: Fridays, March 3, 17, 31, from 4:00-7:00 pm, followed by...
- **Stations of the Cross**: Fridays, March 3, 17, 31, at 7:00 pm, in the church, led by Deacon Frank Pregler.

Let us enter into the holy season with a **real desire for a change of heart** – that we might become ever more fully his missionary disciples!
