Ordination/Religious life:

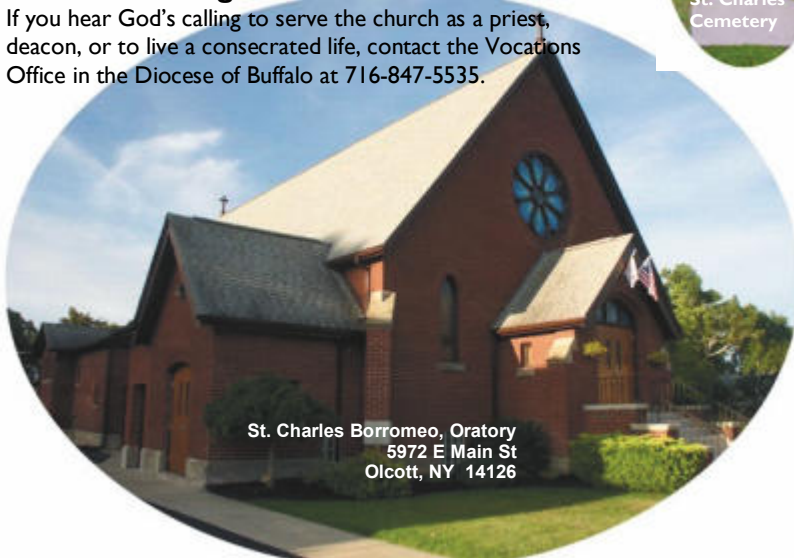
