Second Collection for Hurricane Ida: Archbishop Gomez, President of the USCCB has asked parishes to take up a special collection to support the Church's humanitarian needs arising from Hurricane Ida and the tornados and flooding that followed. Funds collected in the appeal will become part of the Bishops Emergency Disaster Fund and will be used to support the efforts of the USCCB for pastoral and reconstruction needs of the church and/or Catholic Charities USA/Catholic Relief Services as local agencies respond to the immediate emergency needs for such necessities as water, food, shelter, and medical care and aid in long-term rebuilding needs and recovery efforts. Baskets will once again be placed next to the weekly collection baskets and marked Hurricane Ida the weekend of October 24th.

World Mission Sunday: We are also collecting for World Mission Sunday. They help provide resources to missionaries in 1,111 mission diocese throughout the world.

All Saints Day Correction Mass for All Saints Day (is not a Holy Day of Obligation this year) will be celebrated on Monday, November 1 only at 8:30am in Wilson.
