Second Collection for Hurricane Ida: Archbishop Gomez, President of the USCCB has asked parishes to take up a special collection to support the Church's humanitarian needs arising from Hurricane Ida and the tornados and flooding that followed. Funds collected in the appeal will become part of the Bishops Emergency Disaster Fund and will be used to support the efforts of the USCCB for pastoral and reconstruction needs of the church and/or Catholic Charities USA/Catholic Relief Services as local agencies respond to the immediate emergency needs for such necessities as water, food, shelter, and medical care and aid in long-term rebuilding needs and recovery efforts. Baskets are placed next to the weekly collection baskets and marked Hurricane Ida.

World Mission Sunday: We are also collecting for World Mission Sunday. They help provide resources to missionaries in 1,111 mission diocese throughout the world. Please put in regular collection basket. Extra envelopes are located in the back of church if needed.
