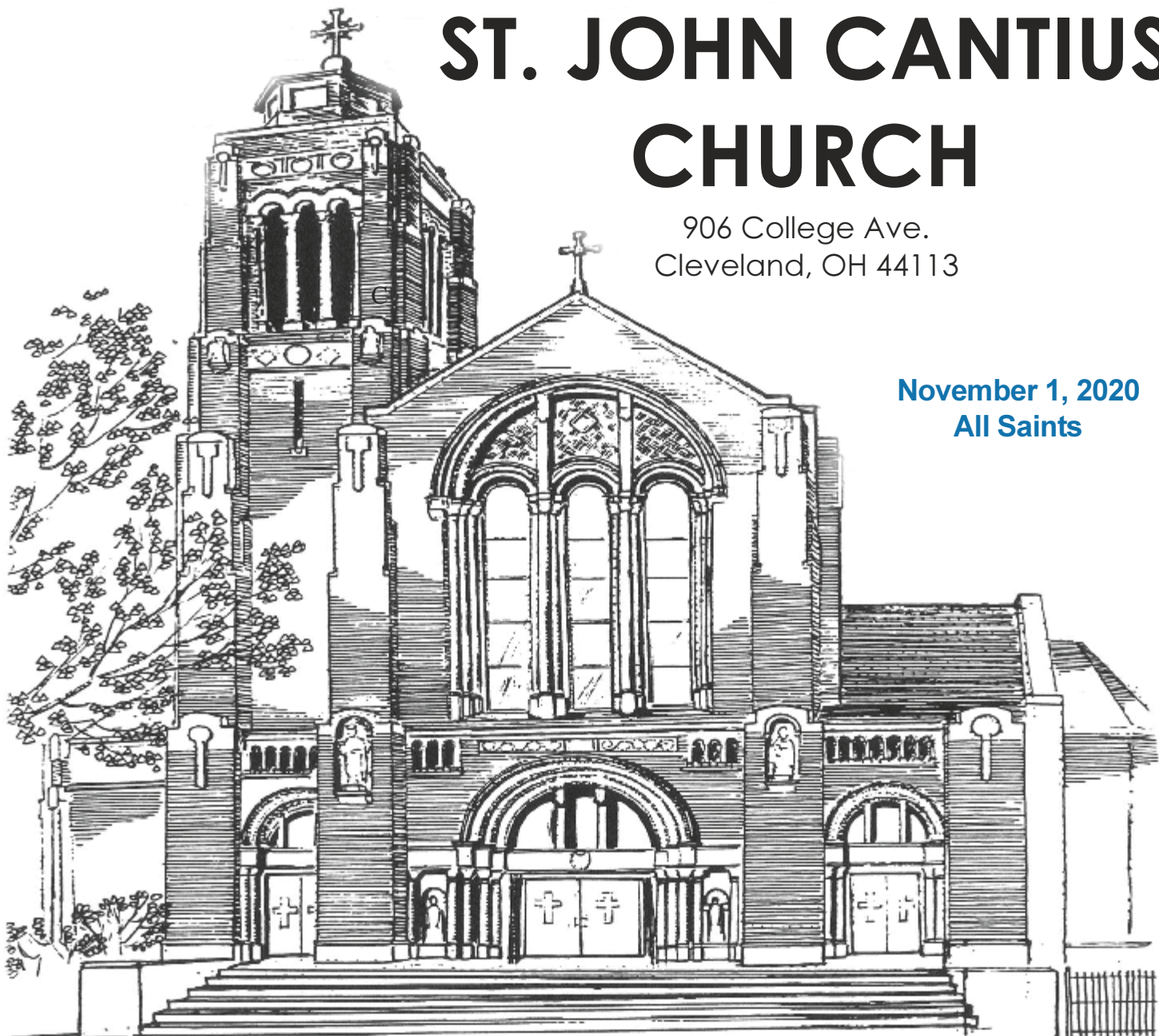

PASTOR'S THOUGHTS

The month of November has traditionally been a month of prayer for the deceased. It begins November 1st, All Saints Day, praying to the faithful who have already reached heaven (Church Triumphant). The Church also remembers the faithfully departed who are still expiating their sins in Purgatory (Church Suffering) and of the pilgrim faithful still here on earth awaiting God's call to join Him (the Church Militant).

The Catholic Church teaches that the purification of the souls in Purgatory can be hastened by the actions of the faithful on earth. This teaching is based upon the practice of prayer for the dead mentioned as far back as 2 Maccabees 12:42-46 in the Old Testament written around the second century BC. There is also evidence of praying for the deceased in the inscriptions, paintings, and iconography of the catacombs in the second and third centuries AD.

To commemorate the Church's practice of praying for our beloved deceased, I have prepared a Book of the Deceased in Church where you will be able to write the names of your deceased loved ones. We will pray all month for those listed in our Book of the Dead along with your All Souls Day envelopes which we will place on the altar. The lectern with the "Book of the Deceased" will be located near the front of the church with a candle. Please come forward anytime in November and write the name of your deceased loved ones in for prayers. If you are unable to make it to church for any reason please do not hesitate to call Joe or myself and we will gladly place the name(s) of your loved ones in the "Book of the Deceased."

All Saints Day occurs on a Sunday this year. At all of our weekend Masses, we will be celebrating All Saints Day by using the readings and prayers from All Saints rather than the normal Sunday readings/prayers. All Souls Day, Monday November 2nd is NOT a required day (Obligation) to attend Mass either. It never was. However, something to consider: The Church grants a full Plenary Indulgence (total remission of all temporal punishment due to sin) to any loved one in Purgatory if the living devoutly visits a church on All Souls Day, recites an Our Father, and says the Creed for their loved one. We will have our usually scheduled 630pm Mass on Monday November 2nd followed by the Miraculous Medal Novena. Please consider joining us that Monday November 2nd (All Souls Day) to offer up prayers for your deceased love ones and gain an Plenary Indulgence for them. UROCZYSTOSC WSZYSTKICH SWIETYCH

Uroczystość Wszystkich Świętych jest świętem nieznanym Świętych. Wiele narodów posiada pomniki i wspomnienia „nieznanych bohaterów”. Niewielu jest sławnych bohaterów, o których pisze się książki i którym stawia się pomniki. Bardzo wielu jest nieznanym bohaterów, o których nie wiadomo nawet gdzie spoczywają. Zeby okazać im wdzięczność, wznosi się ku ich czci jeden wspólny pomnik

Również nasz Kościół ma swoich nieznanym bohaterów, Świętych, o których nikt specjalnie nie pamięta. Tych właśnie nieznanym bohaterów-Swiętych dzisiaj w szczególny sposób czcimy. Wspominamy ich, prosimy o ich wstawiennictwo, ponieważ są to nasi bracia, nasi przyjaciele i nasi orędownicy u Boga.

Dzisiejsza uroczystość jest jednocześnie poważnym wezwaniem do świętości. Nadejdzie dzień, w którym każdy z nas powinien znaleźć się w gronie tych „nieznanych bohaterów”, Świętych naszego Kościoła. Trzeba to jednak rozpocząć już dzisiaj. Wszyscy jesteśmy powołani do świętości: „Popatrzcie, jaką miłością obdarzył nas Ojciec: zostaliśmy nazwani dziećmi Bożymi i rzeczywiście nimi jesteśmy”.

Musimy przyznać, że w naszym Kościele za mało jest świętości i świętych, a zbyt wielu jest grzeszników. Ojciec Święty w imieniu Jezusa Chrystusa wzywa świat chrześcijański do modlitwy i do autentycznego chrześcijańskiego życia zmierzającego do świętości. Tylko w ten sposób człowiek staje się bardziej człowiekiem i bardziej chrześcijaninem. Tylko święte, chociaż często nieznanne dusze, uświęcają, ożywiają i odnawiają Kościół. Więcej robi dla kościoła nieznanne święta matka przy kołysce niż wielce uczonego profesor bez świętości, chociażby mówił o nim cały świat. Jego mądrość bez świętości prowadzi często do zguby, i to nie tylko jego samego.

Uroczystość Wszystkich Świętych wzywa nas wszystkich do pójścia śladami Świętych. Często zwracamy się do świętych z różnymi modlitwami. Czy jednak była chociaż jedna prośba, żeby nam wyprosilili autentyczne i święte życie chrześcijańskie? Najczęściej są to czyste ziemskie intencje. Lubimy Świętych, ale nie lubimy świętości. Zbyt wiele nas to kosztuje. Należałoby wyrwać ze swego zatrutego serca „chwast zła” – grzech, a taka operacja boli. Za wszelką cenę trzeba być świętym, prawdziwym i autentycznym chrześcijaninem. Jeżeli tego nie pragniemy, nigdy nimi nie będziemy.
