Lenten Regulations

Every Catholic, to enter more deeply into the life of Christ, is to participate in some way in the spiritual & penitential disciplines of Lent. The regulations of the Catholic Church in the United States are as follows:

- The obligation to abstain from meat binds Catholics 14 years of age and older. The obligation to **fast** binds Catholics from the age of 18 to 59. Those younger or older are encouraged to voluntarily embrace these disciplines in so far as they are able. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting & abstinence. Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.
- Throughout Lent, Catholics are especially encouraged to perform voluntary acts of penance.
- With any penitential discipline, both the letter & the spirit are to be maintained. For example, replacing meat with a gourmet seafood meal is not in keeping with a penitential practice. Also, hosting "crawfish boils" on Good Friday is inappropriate. Good Friday remains an extraordinary and solemn day on which we recall the suffering & death of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Good Friday should remain a day of prayer, penance, and interior and exterior quiet.
